I. Overview

1. The Central Asian Countries Initiative for Land Management (CACILM) is a partnership of the 5 Central Asian countries and major development organizations dedicated to combating land degradation and improving rural livelihoods in Central Asia. CACILM is being implemented in a multicountry framework which includes national projects based on the National Programming Framework of each participating countries as well as activities spanning all five countries. As one of the multicountry projects, the CACILM Multicountry Partnership Framework Support Project (CMPFSP) guides the implementation of the partnership activities; coordinates national and multicountry activities, and support the implementation of the National Programming Frameworks (NPFs) in each Central Asian countries.

2. The CMFSP has 3 multicountry components including: (i) SLM- Research, SLM-Information system; and SLM Knowledge Management which is being implemented by ADB. The KM aims to manage and process knowledge generated in implementing the NPFs, SLM-Research and SLM-IS; and share these information better, faster, for sustainable land management.

3. This report presents the 2007 accomplishments of the SLM-KM component being implemented by ADB.

II. Accomplishment

4. The major accomplishment of the KM component is the preparation of the KM plan and operation of the CACILM Knowledge Network (CKN-previously LEARN project). The KM plan which was presented and approved by the Steering Committee on its 1st meeting on 30-31 October 2007 in Bishkek, Kyrgyz Republic has 4 components: (i) KM Plan; (ii) CACILM Knowledge Network (previously LEARN); (iii) Knowledge products; (iv) Information dissemination. The CKN is a cost effective platform in coordinating and monitoring project activities both at the multicountry and national levels and communicating project information to project team members and other stakeholders. CKN facilitates sharing of information and a forum of SLM experts and practitioners to enhance knowledge generated by the project.

5. Progress of the achievement based on the design and monitoring framework (DMF) of the SLM-KM component based on the DMF of CMPFSP is shown below.

III. Issues and Concerns

A. Increase usage of CKN

6. A survey was conducted to solicit feedback from CKN users which will serve as basis in planning for 2008. A total 9 respondents (from NSECs) provided feedback. Below of is the summary of their comments including suggestions raised during the NSECs planning meeting in January 2008.

(i) Usage Problems

- Download slow
- Complicated structure of the website
- Website is only in English language
- Registration requirements
- Lack of time to work with KM network due to other responsibilities
- NSEC staff expect to be paid in working on the website
- Slow internet in Turkmenistan
- The website is somewhat user friendly

(ii) NSECs proposal to improve the KM network

- Conduct additional/follow-up training
- Create counter to see quantity of visitors
- Make easier access for other users
- Website translation to Russian language (also Kazakhstan)
- Use experience of other websites to simplify CKN
- Extra payment for the person in –charge
- Prepare list of documents which should be in the website; one format to all NECs

- Make the website more functional
- (iv) Preferred information in the CKN
- Information on Sustainable Land Management
 - Information on CACILM Initiatives and projects
 - Country Case studies
 - Lessons learned
- (iii) Knowledge of KM Focal Person on CKN tools
- Those who attended the CKN training have basic knowledge on the use of CKN tools but requires follow-up training on the following:
 - No/Little Knowledge on the following CKN Tools
 - Hosting a forum/meeting
 - Link Page
 - Creating forms
 - Editing document
 - Moving a file
 - Creation of multiple page
 - Notifying members
 - Posting pictures
 - Deleting files
 - No trained focal person in NSEC TAJ

B. Participation of national projects teams in the CKN.

7. Project team of national projects (ADB, GT, UNDP) in each of the 5 countries which has been organized need to be included in the CKN members; manage their respective rooms and provide project updates regularly. This requires orientation training to inform them of the use of CKN and hands on training of their respective focal person who will manage their rooms in the CKN.

IV. Recommendation for 2008 Workplan

A. CACILM Knowledge Network

8. Based on the feedback from the survey, the following should be included in 2008 workplan.
- Translation from English to Russian of relevant rooms/pages.
 - Conduct Orientation training on CKN usage; purpose, role in CACILM; to all CACILM project teams-NSEC, MSEC, SLM-IS, SLM-R, SLM-CB, ADB and UNDP projects.
 - Conduct hands-on/follow-up training on using CKN tools in maintaining respective room to room owners/CKN focal person to all CACILM project teams – MSEC; NSEC, Multicountry components, national projects.
Training design to address identified training needs of the CKN focal persons; and to the needs of the new CKN focal persons from NSEC TAJ, SLM-IS; ADB and UNDP projects
 - Encourage ADB and UNDP projects to be on board in the CKN; maintain respective rooms.
 - Agreed schedule and approach in updating the CKN- e.i, what documents to be uploaded, when, where, by whom.

B. Knowledge Products and Information Dissemination

9. Implementation of 2 knowledge products project proposal once approved by the Steering Committee and the information dissemination plan of each NSEC.
