

**Clean Energy Financing Partnership Facility (CEFPF)  
or Climate Change Fund (CCF)  
Categories of Direct Charges**

1. ***Knowledge, Capacity and Innovation Services.*** Activities and products under this category may include toolkits for operations staff to dialogue with stakeholders; model templates and procedures (including performance benchmarking and peer review); technical studies; papers on issues, good practice and advocacy; information, education and communication campaigns (IEC); initiation of/participation in events (including workshops, study tours and industry/technology fairs) to maximize information acquisition and dissemination, as well as partnership and networking; development of technical and management capacity to support CCF implementation; and, monitoring and evaluation missions.
2. ***Expert Services for Project Support.*** Expert services represent activities that help rapidly deploy skilled individuals to ADB's operations departments to aid in project planning, design, implementation, monitoring and evaluation, and adaptive management. CCF may supplement ADB's internal staff resources (including Project/Program Preparatory Technical Assistance and project consultants) with additional skills from a separate pool of contracted and seconded consultants to be sourced by the fund. Skills that may be needed incrementally during the project process include those in: renewable energy technologies, energy efficiency technologies, clean fuel technologies, carbon sequestration, energy transmission and distribution, business development, capacity/institutional assessment and development, stakeholder analysis and development, and IEC design and implementation.
3. ***Regional and Partnership Development.*** The CCF will initiate and/or participate in regional cooperation activities that increase clean energy financing, catalyze CE enabling policies and reforms, build capacity and institutions for clean energy development and implementation, share knowledge and experience on CE development and implementation, develop technology and process models for replication. In this regard, the CCF may co-sponsor ADB's annual Clean Energy Forum.
