Kerr is currently Van Vliet Professor of International Trade at the University of Saskatchewan, Canada and Senior Associate of the Estey Centre for Law and Economics in International Trade, Saskatoon, Canada. He has a PhD in economics from the University of British Columbia. His research has centred on international trade and international commercial policy but he has also written extensively on globalisation, technological change, international development and environmental economics. He has worked as a consultant for the World Bank, The Inter-American Development Bank, the Canadian and British governments and private industry. He has over 250 academic publications including ten co-authored books. Recent titles include *Economic Analysis for EU Accession Negotiations*, *The Economics of International Business – A Guide to the Global Commercial Environment*, *Economic Analysis for International Trade Negotiations* and *Regional Trading Blocs in the Global Economy – The EU and ASEAN*. He is editor of *The Estey Centre Journal of International Law and Trade Policy*.
