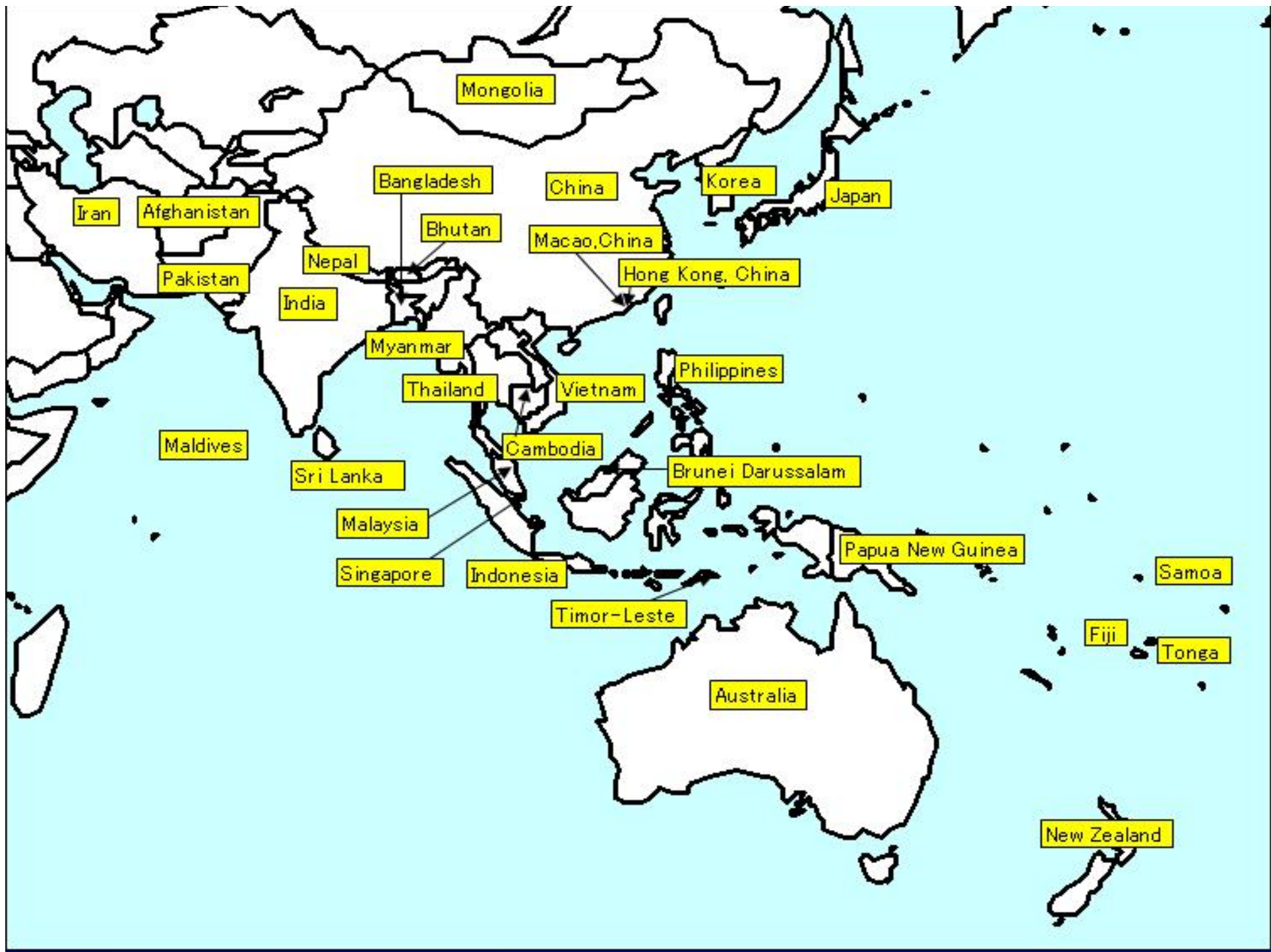

- Organize WCO Regional Diagnostic Framework workshops to foster diagnostic experts
 - Four Workshops, More than 30 certified
- Conduct Diagnosis Missions
 - 10 diagnosis missions in AP
- Organized Action Plans Development Workshop
 - 1 regional and 2 national workshops

Partnership with Donors

- Cooperation with Asian Development Bank (ADB)
 - Series of meetings at ADB Headquarters to develop cooperation since November 2004
