



**Frans Vanistendael** is the Academic Chairman of the International Bureau of Fiscal Documentation (IBFD) in Amsterdam. He studied law, economics and philosophy at Katholieke Universiteit Leuven in Belgium and at the Chicago and Yale law schools. He has been professor of tax law at KU Leuven since 1972. He was a visiting professor at Kansai (Osaka), Monash (Melbourne), Rome and Sydney. He served his country as Royal Commissioner for Tax Reform (1986-1987), as a cabinet advisor to the Minister of Finance (1980-1992) and as a member of the High Council of Finance (1980-2000). He is an expert with the European Commission on the harmonization of tax law and a consultant with the IMF and the OECD. Mr. Vanistendael is also a member of the Brussels bar. He was the first and founding president of the European Law Faculties Association (1995-1997). He was co-founder in 1999 of the European Association of Tax Law Professors (EATLP) and is currently its Vice-president. He was also dean of the Faculty of Law at KU Leuven (1999-2005). He was member of the Executive Board of the International Fiscal Association (IFA) (2000-2006) and is currently member of the IFA Permanent Scientific Committee. He is member of the Executive Board of the International Association of Law Schools (IALS) and co-founder and chairman of the EC Tax review since 1992.
