 - facilitates financing for energy projects

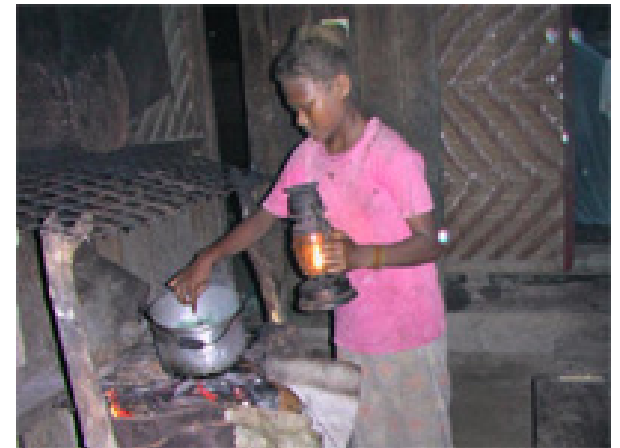


the journey

- Community training for installation & lifecycle support for RE & EE systems

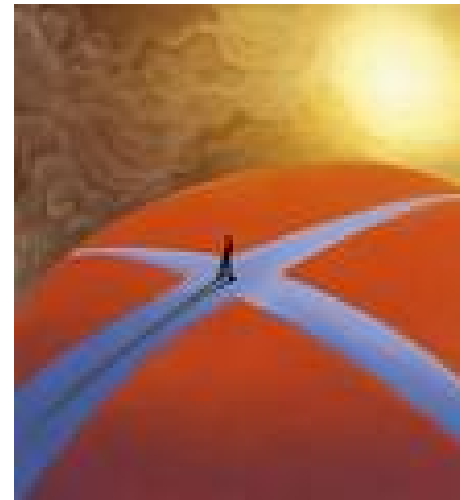
