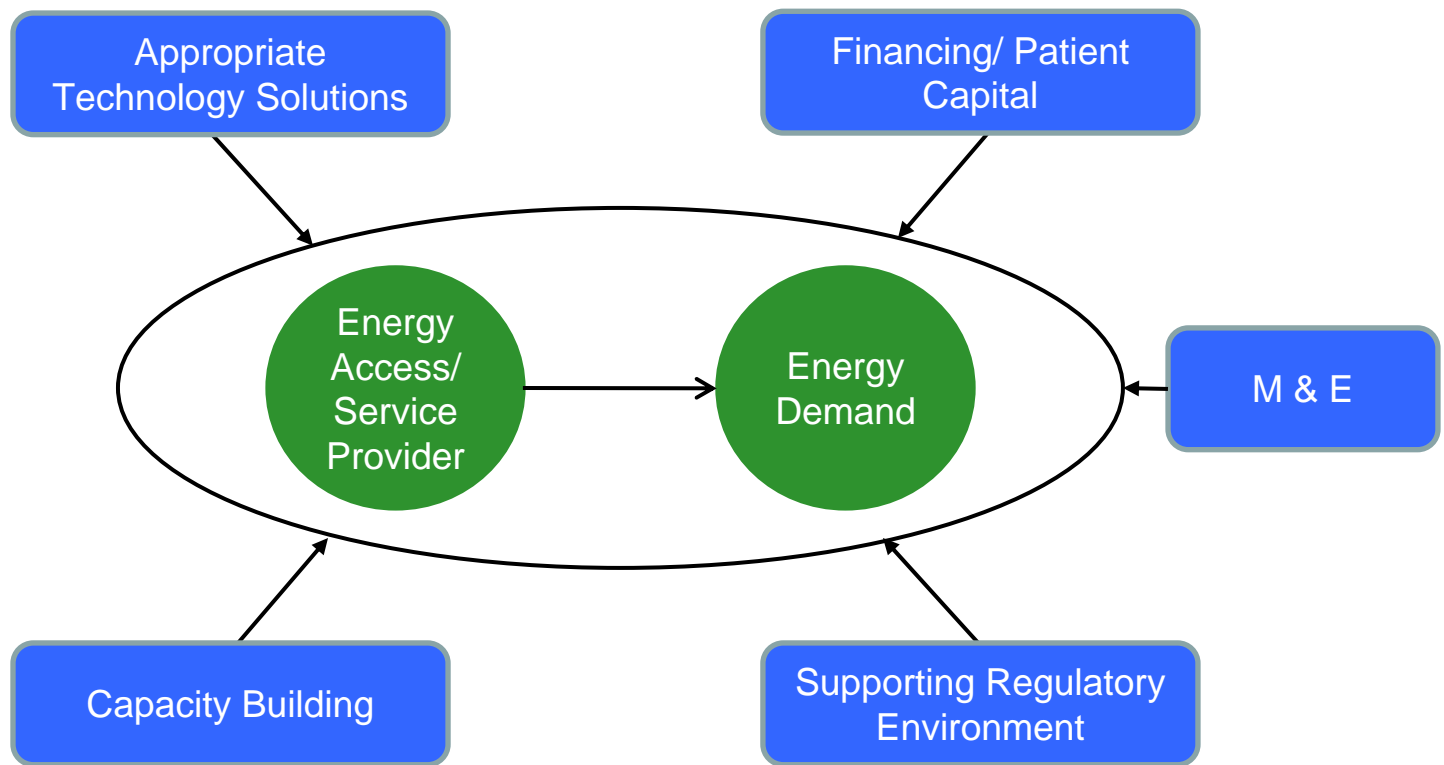
Basic Philosophy

- To develop financially sustainable, pro-poor, energy access supply chains
 - Bottom up approach
 - Appropriate and affordable energy solutions based on end user requirements
 - Viable local market and networks that support the technology

2. Effective scale up of energy access can be achieved through multiple small actions.



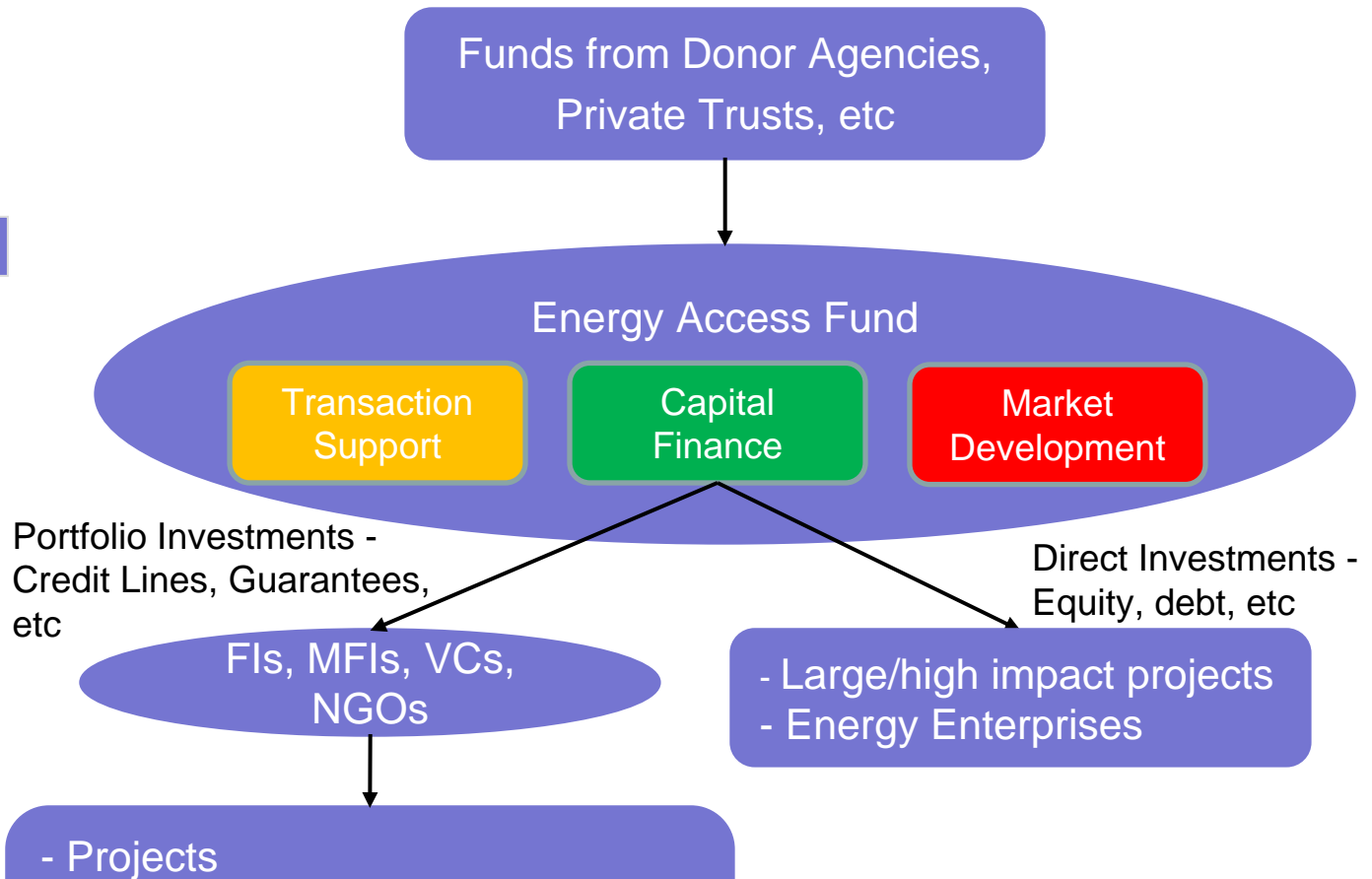

 - Aligned to the fund
 - DEEP Project , E. Africa – targeting the creation of 1800 micro and small energy enterprises in 5 years
- Stakeholder Platforms
 - Coordinated action across a wide range of stakeholders to ensure greater sustainability of initiatives
 - Platform in Peru has been very successful in arriving at a coordinated strategy for renewables and biofuels
 - Similar platform to be established in Honduras and Ghana shortly
- M&E
 - M&E training courses to build local capacity
 - Assess the demand for a dedicated service centre

- Focus on sustainable energy enterprise – does it exclude the bottom of the pyramid?

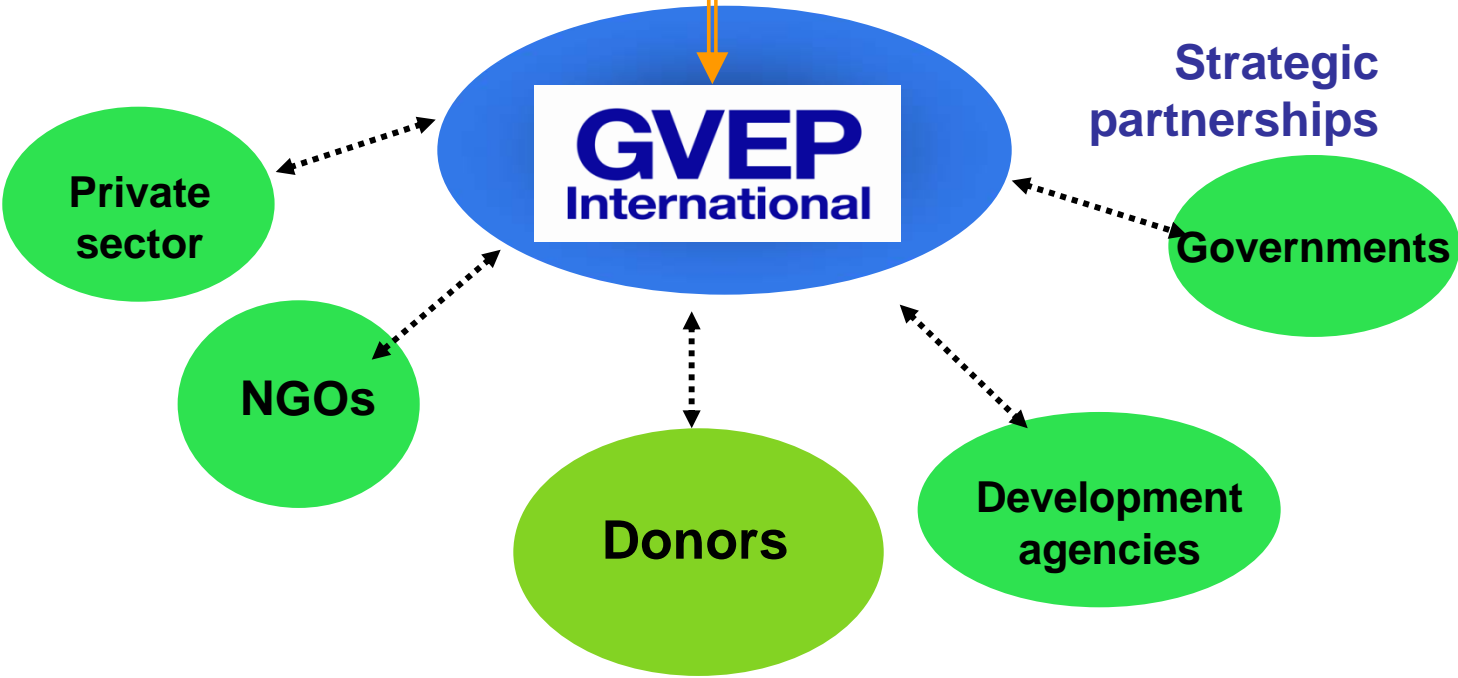
