<b>Project Identification/ ISA</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Identify stakeholders.</li> <li>• Identify vulnerable groups.</li> <li>• Involve stakeholders and vulnerable groups in consultative processes.</li> <li>• Prepare information campaign and plans for dissemination.</li> <li>• Organize public meetings.</li> <li>• Decide on the need for social preparation phase.</li> </ul>
