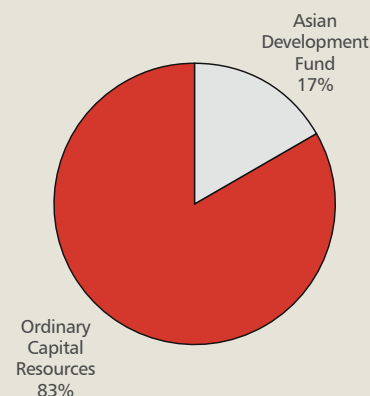
## Sovereign Lending

ADB has approved this year 29 loans to 12 developing member countries totaling \$3.67 billion. Approved loans from ADB's Ordinary Capital Resources (OCR) total \$3.03 billion, while \$641 million came from ADB's concessional Asian Development Fund (ADF). About 36% of the loans went to projects in the transport and communications sector, and 24% to energy sector projects. The rest went to projects in agriculture and natural resources; finance; health, nutrition, and social protection; law, economic management, and public policy; and water supply, sanitation, and waste management.
