Operations Updates, 2008*

Sovereign Lending

ADB has approved this year 83 loans to 19 developing member countries totaling \$8.71 billion. Approved loans from ADB's ordinary capital resources (OCR) total \$6.92 billion, while \$1.79 billion came from ADB's concessional Asian Development Fund (ADF). About 29% of the loans went to transport and communications projects, 22% to law, economic management, and public policy projects, 18% to multisector projects, 16% to energy projects, 5% to agriculture and natural resources projects, 5% to water supply, sanitation, and waste management projects, 2% to industry and trade projects, 2% to health, nutrition, and social protection projects, 1% to education projects, and 0.1% to finance projects.

Nonsovereign Operations

ADB has approved 16 nonsovereign projects worth \$2,478.31 million.

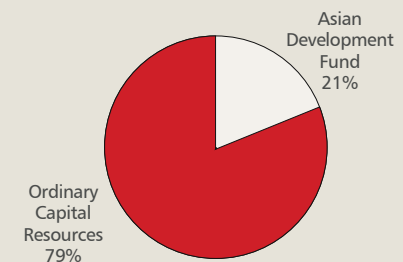
Grants

ADB has approved 51 grant-financed projects totaling \$811.38 million, 197 country technical assistance projects worth \$157.72 million, and 102 regional technical assistance projects totaling \$116.78 million.
