Part 1 provides background on the organization—its mandate; structures; and Strategy 2020, ADB's new long-term strategic framework.

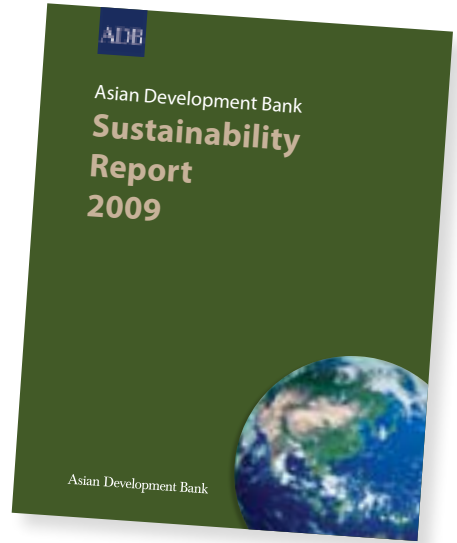
Part 2 features ADB's work on three important aspects of sustainable development in Asia and the Pacific:
