

APTRACK

PRE-REQUISITES

APTRACK needs to be installed on any ONE machine which is on the Local Area Network (LAN). This machine will become the APTRACK Server. All other machines on the LAN will be able to access APTRACK through the APTRACK Server.

Following are the requirements for the APTRACK Server -

Check for Hardware

1. Availability of CD Drive for installing APTRACK CD. This CD Drive can be in the local machine where APTRACK to be loaded, else in shared network.
2. Minimum 25 MB hard disk space, recommended 50 MB
3. Minimum 128 MB RAM, recommended 256 MB

Check for Operating System

1. APTRACK can be installed only on the following Operating systems -
 - Windows 98
 - Windows XP Professional
 - Windows 2000 Professional

Check for Web Server

To install APTRACK on a **Windows 98** machine check for Personal Web Server (PWS) in the system.

Check for Personal Web Server (PWS) in the system

- Open Start -> All Programs -> Internet Explorer -> Personal Web Manager
- An icon of PWS must be appearing in the task bar (Right Bottom part where other icons getting displayed)

If you don't find out the Personal Web Server as per the above checks, please follow the following steps to install Personal Web Service (PWS) in the system

- Get Windows 98 CD.
- Open "addons" folder in the root
- Open PWS and Run setup.exe
- Once PWS gets installed , it will ask for restarting the computer. So save and close all your opened programs and restart the machine.
- Once your system got restarted, please check for the above steps to find out whether PWS is installed or not.

To install APTRACK on a **Windows XP Professional / 2000 Professional** machine check for IIS.

Check for Internet Information service (IIS) in the system

- Open Start -> Control Panel -> Administration Tools -> Internet Service Manager
OR
Open Start -> Settings -> Control Panel -> Administration Tools -> Internet Service Manager
- Open Start -> Run. Type down "inetmgr" in the area provided and press enter. Pressing Enter should open the Internet Information Manager window.

If you don't find out the Internet Information Service as per the above checks, please follow the following steps to install Internet Information Service (IIS) in the system

- Open Start -> Control Panel -> Add / Remove Programs
OR
Open Start -> Settings -> Control Panel -> Add / Remove Programs
- Click on Add Windows Component option available on the left side of the window opened.
- The above step will open another window with the title as Windows Component Wizard. Select Internet Information Services (IIS) from the list of components and click on Next and setup will be started.
- You might require your Windows XP Professional / 2000 Professional operating system for installation. Please contact your system administrator for installing IIS in your system. You may remove APTRACK CD from the CD drive for this process. Once you are through with your IIS installation, then put APTRACK again.
- Once IIS gets installed , IIS installation process may ask for restarting the computer. So save and close all your opened programs and restart the machine.
- Once your system got restarted, please check for the above steps to find out whether IIS is installed or not.

Check for Other Software - These are required on ALL machine from which you wish to access APTRACK

1. Microsoft Internet Explorer 5.0 or more
2. Microsoft Office 2000 / XP
