

# NORTH EAST COMMUNITY RESTORATION AND DEVELOPMENT PROJECT

## Project Area

The Project will be implemented in the 8 districts that make up the Northern and Eastern Provinces, and will cover both cleared and uncleared areas. It will be headquartered in Trincomalee.



## Objective

The Project will contribute to the Government's overall relief and rehabilitation program for the North East, by improving the living conditions and well-being of communities that have been affected by the conflict, particularly communities that contain significant proportions of internally displaced people.

## Scope

The Project will implement a range of complementary activities in the Project area to ensure that the people living there, whether original occupants or people who have been resettled or relocated, experience a broad improvement in their livelihoods and in their access to services, utilities, and income-generating opportunities.

## Concept

The Project will have two broad components:

- larger scale anchor subprojects
- smaller scale community-level subprojects

### **Anchor subprojects:**

- typically investments that will benefit a broad cross-section of each district's population
- will be implemented largely through conventional Government contracting arrangements.

### **Community-level subprojects:**

- typically investments for individuals or specific communities
- will be implemented by local organizations and communities as implementing partners assisted by service providers (Government agencies at the province, district, and division level; project field staff; and NGOs).

## Critical Factors

### **Balance**

The need to ensure that the Project's activities and investments are reasonably distributed between or among, communities, relocated and original communities, cleared

and uncleared areas, urban and rural areas, and others. The Project will give particular attention to those who are most vulnerable, in particular the disabled and households headed by widows or single women.

### **Flexibility**

The need to adjust the Project as the fluid security situation requires, as populations move in response to security events or changes in Government policies, and as other projects develop.

## Process Approach

The Project will be implemented using a process approach, to provide the flexibility needed to refine and adjust scope and methodology in the fluid situation that exists in the Project area.
