We have been affected by the Asian Development Bank Greater Mekong Sub-Region Phnom Penh – Hochimin Highway Loan Project (1659-CAM). Through the technical assistance project for capacity building to manage risks, Asian Development Bank Resettlement Project (TA6091-REG) conducted an auditing on the road construction project, however, our problems have not been addressed.

Objective: Request to the Director of Special Project Facilitation for additional funding to us who have been poor, losing livelihoods and in heavy debt. In addition, we live with fear during heavy rain, storm, thunder or thunder strike, in our leave roofed small cottages. We would like to present the following proposals:

- We would like the Director to help Hem Chhay, 60, who is our community member affected by this Highway Construction Project as currently he has not received a new land for resettlement and he and his family have been living in the street;
- We would like the Director to help us obtain titles for our new resettlement land to make us have a secure residence and can put the titles as a collateral to get bank loans;
- We would like to request for development of a project on job creation and funding as a livelihood capital to address our livelihood issues and eliminate poverty;
- We would like the Director to conduct a survey, not only for us, but also for other affected households including those affected but not completely compensated;
- We would like to request the Director to undertaken develop project process in a way that people are not affected by it.

We will submit other additional documents in addition to this grievance complaint.

We would like the Director to respond to me both in Khmer and English.
