b. Period Covered

- One year. *Note: Countries may opt to compile for more than one year.*
- All matrices should be completed for the year 2005 or any latest year for which countries have results of an economic census or other industrial survey.

c. Classification

- The commodity classification should be made using CPC version 1.0 or 1.1. Countries may opt to use the ICP classification in the absence of CPC but should advise ADB beforehand.
- The breakdown by kind of activities should be based on ISIC Rev. 3 or 3.1.
- The classification of expenditure according to purpose  
Household Final Consumption Expenditure - COICOP  
Government Final Consumption Expenditure - COFOG  
Non-profit Institutions Serving Households, Individual – COPNI

d. Dimension

- Level of details for both commodities and kinds of activity will depend on data availability for each country.
- The same classification and level of details should be used for gross output and intermediate consumption.
