- LLDA showed openness and willingness to be subjected to peer review (as shown by consent and support of the leadership)
- The PR Team showed willingness to learn, flexibility and were very cordial
- PR Team showed expertise and understanding of RBO and issues of LLDA

Recommendations:

Specific for Peers

- Peers are encouraged to interact/ engage more with SA team before the visit
- Use the availability of the staff and stakeholders to the maximum
- Explore alternative ways of verifications/ consultations (do not rely only on group meetings)
- Take the advantage of “informal” opportunities to gain more insights from staff and stakeholders

Specific to LLDA

- Peers could have an opportunity to meet Board Member(s)
- Peers and stakeholders to meet without LLDA staff
- Indications of gains/ learning's from the network meetings

Lessons

- A longer (eg. At least 7days) PR is recommended
 - Allocate a day or two for PR team to interact as a team and go through the materials
 - Time to interact with staff
 - Additional day to complete the report.
 - Time for field visits and for core PR activities (document checking) should be balanced.
- Discuss impact of visit on peers (lessons learned)
- PR should be more concerned on the current ratings and helping the RBO to establish current status!
- It looks LLDA is more mature and therefore can be the leading agency for BM
