Amit Shah, the Honorable Mayor of Ahmedabad Municipal Corporation (AMC), was born on 24th August 1959 in Ahmedabad city. He obtained his degrees in Arts major in Economics from G.L.S. Arts College and in Law (with Labour laws) from Sir L. A Shah Law College.

He is the Deputy Accountant of the Ahmedabad District Cooperative Bank Head Office for twenty years. He has been an active worker in RSS, Jan Sangh & Bharatiya Janata Party at Kalupur.

He was the Vice President of Kalupur Ward BJP and the Vice President of Ellisbridge constituency of the City.

In 1995, he was elected as Municipal Councilor of Vasna Ward, Ahmedabad City and served as the Chairman of AMC Octroi Committee. In consultation with the Chamber of Commerce & Industry, he significantly reduced the rates of octroi. During this term, he was also the Deputy Chairman of the AMC Water Supply & Sewerage Committee.

In 2000, he was re-elected as Municipal Councilor. During his term, he served as a member of the Standing Committee—the decision-making body of AMC. In 2003, he was appointed as the Leader of the Opposition of the BJP in AMC.

Being appointed as the City BJP President in Sept. 2005, he was elected for the third time as Municipal Councilor in October 2005. On 23 October 2005, he was elected as the AMC Mayor.
