1. The People’s Republic of Bangladesh (“the borrower”) has received financing from ADB, AFD and GEF towards the cost of **Greater Dhaka Sustainable Urban Transport Project**. Part of this financing will be used for payments under the contract named above. Bidding is open to Bidders from eligible source countries of ADB.

2. The **Road and Highways Department** (“the Employer”) invites sealed bids from eligible Bidders to bid under one package for a plant (design, supply, and installation) contract for the following:

<ul style="list-style-type: none">Solar-powered Highway Lighting - It will include at least 2000 stand-alone solar-powered streetlights on both sides of the BRT road and provision of Solar Panels at Bus Station.Time for completion of the works from the commencement date will be 12 months.

3. **International Competitive Bidding (ICB)** will be conducted in accordance with ADB’s [Single-Stage: One Envelope](#) Bidding Procedure. Bidding is open to all bidders from eligible countries as described in the bidding documents (Section 5).

4. Only eligible Bidders with the following key qualifications should participate in the bidding:

- Minimum average annual turnover in an amount equal to USD 14 million calculated as total certified payments received for contracts in progress or completed, within the last three (3) years;
- The Bidder must demonstrate that it has the financial resources to meet (i) its current contract commitments, as defined in FIN-4 (Total Financial Requirements for Current Contract Commitments), plus (ii) the requirements for the Subject Contract of USD 1.75 million.
- Participation in at least one (1) contract that has been successfully or substantially completed within the last ten (10) years and that is similar to the proposed contract, where the value of the Bidder’s participation exceeds USD 4.5 million. The similarity of

the Bidder's participation shall be based on the physical size, nature of works, complexity, methods, technology or other characteristics as described in Section 6 (Employer's Requirements).

- Pay a non-refundable fee of BDT 17,000 or an equivalent amount in USD 200. The mode of payment shall be a pay order in favor of Project Manager-2 (EE), RHD, GDSUTP.

7. Deliver your bid:

- **On or before the deadline: 25 August 2022 at 15:00 hours (Local Time)**
- Together with a Bid Security of USD \$0.125 million or an equivalent amount in a freely convertible currency of eligible member country. For the purpose of determining the equivalent amount of the required Bid Security in a freely convertible currency, the exchange rates published by Bangladesh Bank prevailing on the date 28 days prior to the deadline for bid submission shall be applied.

Bids will be opened immediately after the deadline for bid submission in the presence of Bidders' representatives who choose to attend.
