Description	<p>The objective of the TA is to assist JPG to prepare a project suitable for ADB financing by assessing the technical, environmental, financial, economic, social and institutional feasibility of a proposed project to (i) increase the wastewater treatment capacity and improve the urban ecological environment in Changchun which would contribute to the clean up of the Songhua river basin (ii) address problems linked to drinking water shortages and water quality issues in Shuangyang district, and Liaoyuan and Meihekou cities, and (iii) promote the sustainable economic development of the project cities. The TA will identify institutional capacity building measures including wastewater management and policy reforms necessary to ensure the long term sustainability of the ensuing Project facilities. The output of the A will be workshops and reports recommending the least cost option for developing wastewater treatment and water supply facilities in Changchun, Liaoyuan and Meihekou cities.</p>
