The remaining positions will be filled by engaging a consulting firm through quality- and cost-based selection method using a quality-cost ratio of 90:10 and biodata technical proposal. Lump-sum or output-based contracts will also be considered for consulting services. The technical assistance will engage consulting firms and individual consultants in accordance with the Asian Development Bank Procurement Policy (2017, as amended from time to time) and the associated project administration instructions and/or staff instructions.
