During Project Design	Participatory methods, such as workshops, rapid assessment, focus group discussions, and surveys, have been employed throughout the feasibility study to ensure that the needs and demands of the weaker social groups such as women, ethnic minorities, and the poor, will be taken into consideration.
During Project Implementation	During Project implementation, WSCs will be trained in community consultation techniques, analysis of customer feedback, and other areas to improve participation. The public health awareness programs, the community environmental sanitation improvement programs, and the sanitation credit schemes will all use participatory approaches.

## Business Opportunities

Consulting Services	About 1,543 person-months of consulting services (215 international and 1,328 domestic) will be required from international consulting firms in association with domestic consultants. There will be two consulting services contracts: project orientation assistance and project implementation assistance. The consultants will comprise experts in the areas of project management, water supply engineering and design, sanitation engineering and design, unaccounted-for-water improvement, construction management, community development, sanitation credit scheme, training and capacity building, and technical support to the Provincial Project Management Units and Project Coordination Unit.
Procurement	Civil works and supply contracts valued above \$1.0 million and \$0.5 million respectively will be procured under international competitive bidding procedures. This will include civil works contracts for the water supply component and a supply contract for UFW equipment. Minor civil works and supply contracts value at or below the above thresholds will be procured following local competitive bidding procedures in accordance with Government's regulations acceptable to ADB.
