
Thank you for your letter dated 13 April 2011 regarding the above subject. We have conducted a review of the RAR and find it appropriate. Identified recommendations will complement on going activities carried out by related stakeholders, especially by the Balai Besar Wilayah Sungai Citarum (BBWSC). Please kindly see below specific comments to be addressed:

Reference	Comments
RAR Para 3	Please clarify the position of Mr Among who is from Kruha as part of ARUM. ARUM and Kruha might be distinct for clarity purpose. This comment is valid for the overall document, especially in section 2, para 9.
RAR Para 7	It is unclear if the complainants tried to address this issue with the executing agency (EA) or with Balai Besar Wilayah Sungai Citarum (BBWSC) in charge of implementing the project. And if so, what has been the answer from BBWSC?
RAR Para 9	The complaint came from Kruha. This should be clearly mentioned and segregated from ARUM. Some confusion might be raised related to the role of ARUM.
RAR Para 24, point (v)	Please replace "due diligence" with "survey"
RAR Para 24, point (viii)	APs to be evicted by the project won't necessarily beneficiate from the water supply and sanitation activities.
RAR Para 27	The proposed dialogue might capitalized on lessons learned from other on going projects (JEDI World Bank) that faced similar issues and for which practical implementation options have been developed.

We nominate **Mr. Abdul Malik Sadat Idris, ST. M. Eng** and **Mrs. Tirta Sutedjo, ST** from Bappenas as participants (i) in the proposed dialogues among DGWR, BBWSC, the Bekasi local government, and PJT II; and (ii) in the multi stakeholder consultation. Mid of June 2011 would be a convenient period for the multi stakeholder consultation.

We are looking forward to work closely with you and ADB to implement smoothly this project.
