### **Biographies of the Speakers**

#### **Tetsushi Sonobe, Dean, Asian Development Bank Institute**

Tetsushi Sonobe is the Dean and CEO of the Asian Development Bank Institute, the Tokyo-based think tank of the Asian Development Bank. Previously, he was Vice President of the National Graduate Institute for Policy Studies, Japan. He is a development economist and holds a PhD in economics from Yale University.

#### **Dennis Snower, President, Global Solutions Initiative; Co-Chair, Think7 Germany 2022**

Dennis Snower is President of the Global Solutions Initiative. He helped formally launch the Think7 (T7), the think tank engagement group of the Group of 7 (G7) which he co-chairs under Germany's 2022 G7 presidency. Previously, he served as Co-Chair of Think 20 (T20) as part of Germany's 2017 Group of 20 (G20) presidency. His research focuses include labor economics, public policy, and inflation-unemployment tradeoffs. He holds a PhD from Princeton University.

#### **Anna-Katharina Hornidge, Director, German Institute of Development and Sustainability; Co-Chair, Think7 Germany 2022**

Anna-Katharina Hornidge is Director of German Institute of Development and Sustainability (IDOS), and a professor at the University of Bonn. Her research focuses on the social construction of knowledge, science, and technology studies, with a regional focus on Southeast and Central Asia and East Africa. She also serves as an advisor to several national, regional, and international advisory boards. She received a PhD in Sociology from Technische Universität Berlin and the National University of Singapore.

#### **Bambang Brodjonegoro, Professor of Economics, University of Indonesia; Lead Co-Chair, Think20 Indonesia 2022**

Bambang Brodjonegoro is a professor of economics at the University of Indonesia and a Lead Co-Chair of Think20 Indonesia 2022. He is also President Commissioner of PT. Telkom Indonesia Tbk and PT. Bukalapak.com. Previously, he served as Finance Minister and Development Planning Minister of Indonesia. Bambang earned his PhD from the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign.

#### **Sachin Chaturvedi, Director General, Research and Information System for Developing Countries, India**

Sachin Chaturvedi is Director General of Research and Information System for Developing Countries, a New Delhi-based policy research institute supported by the Government of India. He is also on the board of the Reserve Bank of India. He works on issues related to development economics,

development finance, the Sustainable Development Goals and South-South cooperation, and trade, investment, and innovation linkages, with a special focus on the World Trade Organization. He was Global Justice Fellow at the MacMillan Center for International Affairs at Yale University
