## OPERATIONS MANUAL POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

These policies and procedures were prepared for use by ADB staff and are not necessarily a complete treatment of the subject. This *Operations Manual* was prepared and issued by the Strategy, Policy, and Partnerships Department (SPD) with the approval of the President. Questions may be directed to the director of the Strategic Partnerships Division of SPD.

## **DEVELOPMENT PARTNERSHIPS**

- 1. The Asian Development Bank (ADB) aims to foster economic growth and cooperation in Asia and the Pacific and help accelerate economic development in its developing member countries, collectively and individually. To achieve this, the Agreement Establishing the Asian Development Bank (the Charter) states that ADB may cooperate, in such manner as ADB deems appropriate within the terms of the Charter, with the United Nations, the United Nations' organs and subsidiary bodies, and other public or private international and national institutions and entities concerned with the investment of development funds in the region. ADB may also interest such institutions and entities in new opportunities for investment and assistance (endnote i).
- 2. ADB partners with a diverse group of institutions to address the risks and challenges facing the region and to meet the many requirements for achieving inclusive growth, environmentally sustainable growth, and regional integration (endnote ii). Therefore, ADB continues to strengthen partnerships with multilateral and bilateral institutions, the private sector, and civil society organizations to complement its core activities and other areas of operations through sharing knowledge and expertise (endnote iii).
