2	Students benefiting from new or improved educational facilities (number) Female/Male	By 2023, about 35,000 workers will complete skills/vocational training; Vietnamese and female workers reaching 8% and 46%, respectively	Targeted SME vocational skills training for PRC, Vietnamese, and ASEAN workers on (i) automaking, (ii) advance manufacturing, (iii) electronic information, (iv) medical and health human resources, etc.
3	Cross-border cargo volume facilitated (tons per year)	By 2023, Guangxi's cross-border trade with Viet Nam reaches \$32 billion <sup>a</sup>	Cross-border trade value will be doubled from the 2015 baseline of \$16.3 billion.
