The measure considered is the revision of LDC human resources policies to include clear provisions on gender equality standards and against any forms of harassment (with specific mention of anti-sexual harassment) in each of the project country (2020 baseline: n/a). Five countries included are India, Indonesia, Thailand, Pakistan, and Viet Nam.  |

Target to train at least 30 female cotton farmer group educators in India on climate-resilient cotton farming best practices (2020 baseline: 0)<br>b. Target to train at least 50 coffee farmer group educators in Indonesia on climate-resilient coffee farming best practices (2020 baseline: 0)<br>c. Total farmer group educators trained is 80 (30 cotton farmers + 50 coffee farmers) |

Total farmer group educators trained is 160 (60 cotton farmers + 100 coffee farmers)                   |

| 7.2           | Trade and investment facilitated (\$)  | \$0.03 billion        | Refers to DMF outcome indicator b. The target is to increase trade of agricultural products from India, Indonesia, Thailand, and Viet Nam to \$1.10 billion from 2020 baseline of \$1.07 billion.  |
