6.1.1	Government officials with increased capacity to design, implement, monitor, and evaluate relevant measures (number)	At least one knowledge sharing event for KI 2022 conducted where government officials, particularly from national statistical systems are invited	In addition to featuring macro socioeconomic data, KI includes a chapter on areas that national statistical systems can strengthen their capacity for enhanced compilation of data for development. In particular, the chapter discusses best practices and identifies areas for improvement on specific topics related to compilation of official statistics and other business processes of national statistical systems.
6.1.3	Measures supported in implementation that promote resilience and responsiveness to economic shocks in a timely manner (number)	At least 25,000 downloads of KI 2022 and 10,000 downloads of Basic Statistics 2022	Data on SDGs featured in KI provide analytical insights on pace of progress with respect to poverty reduction and other international development targets, allowing identification of areas for which efforts need to be accelerated. Furthermore, data on economic growth, prices, monetary and financial indicators featured in KI provide analytical insights on macroeconomic performance of regional members amid varying economic regimes, allowing identification of areas for which efforts need to be accelerated.
7.2.1	Measures to improve provisions in existing or new trade or investment agreements supported in implementation (number)	At least 25,000 downloads of KI 2022 and relevant supplement featuring global value chain statistics	Data on global value chain participation of select regional members featured in KI and KI supplement provide analytical insights on how international production networks are affected by varying economic regimes. Such data are useful for calibrating trade policies.
