This considers 10% wastage based on the global standard for liquid vaccines supplied in multi-dose vials of 10 or more doses. Evidence of vaccine administration will be based on Department of Health vaccination records. The expected wastage rate may be updated based on the average acceptable wastage rate for the specific vaccine(s) selected. |
| 1.3 | Poor and vulnerable people with improved standards of living (number) | 16,701,067 | Number of indigent senior citizens and indigent population inoculated with COVID-19 vaccines (indicated in the government vaccine allocation plan). |
| 1.1.2 | Health services established or improved (number) | 1 | This project will bring additional COVID-19 vaccine doses for public use into the Philippines. COVID-19 vaccines are counted as a type of health service. |
| 2.3.2 | Measures on gender equality supported in implementation (number) | 1 | Gender and socially inclusive protocol on the deployment and administration of vaccines (addressing the specific needs of marginalized women and women in especially difficult circumstances, including those in major cities and geographically isolated and disadvantaged areas). |
| 7.3.3 | Measures to improve regional public health and education services supported in implementation (number) | 1 | The project will support implementation of the Philippine National Deployment and Vaccination Plan for COVID-19 Vaccines, including establishing a vaccine information management system, which will reduce the transmission of COVID-19 within the Asia-Pacific region. |
