2.3	Solutions to prevent or address gender-based violence implemented (number)	5	The program will develop and deliver curriculum for adolescent girls focusing on confidence and leadership, GBV and healthy and safe relationships, sexual and reproductive health. In parallel, adolescent boys will be engaged to support safe and healthy relationships and parents/caregivers of the girls in the program will also be actively engaged to ensure they support the information being given to girls.
2.5	Women and girls with increased resilience to climate change, disasters, and other external shocks (number)	250	Women beneficiaries will be supported with trainings and seed grants to establish their own home-based enterprises to address impacts of COVID-19 and position them to be more economically resilient against future external shocks.
