1.3	Poor and vulnerable people with improved standards of living (number)	1,840	Refers to DMF outcome indicators c and e (but only counting those workers from Myanmar, Viet Nam, and Sri Lanka). Workers from these three countries are considered poor and improvement in livelihood is measured in terms of improvement of their annual income. The target by 2022 is to sustain number of workers at 1,840 (2019 baseline is 1,840) and increase their income to \$4,000 (2019 baseline is \$3,700) Breakdown: Myanmar is 255, Viet Nam is 1,451, and Sri Lanka is 134.
2.2.3	Solutions to prevent or address gender-based violence implemented (number)	2	Refer to DMF output indicator 3a (communication of information via electric means) and indicator 3b (designation of special contact person within human resources to support staff experiencing domestic violence). Target year is 2021. The company is currently not doing these mechanisms.
5.2.3	Agribusiness integrating farmers in efficient value chains (number)	1	NHS is being referred as the agribusiness company. Its operation is sustained during COVID-19 crisis, thus continuously integrating the farmers.
7.2	Trade and investment facilitated (\$)	\$180 million per year	Refers to DMF output indicator 1b. Aggregate value of imported raw materials for feed production sustained at \$180 million per year (2019 baseline is \$180 million)
