Target refers to at least 80% of ICS customers, of which 80% women, sustainably use the ICS as primary cooking source which leads to improved living standards as air pollution is minimized. 2.1	Skilled jobs for women generated (number)	75	Refer to DMF Output 3a. Target refers to the annual number of additional jobs provided during operations increased to a least 250, of which 75 are to women. (FY2022 baseline: 0, 0)
2.1.1	Women and girls completing secondary and tertiary education, and/or other training (number)	No nominal target	Refer to DMF Output 2b. Target refers to at least 90% of total female distribution agents received targeted training on technical aspects of the ICS, quality control, and maintenance standards. (FY2022 baseline: 0)

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3.1.5	Low-carbon solutions promoted and implemented	1	Refer to DMF Output 1a. Targets refers to the total number of ICSs distributed which is considered as low-carbon cooking solution (FY2022 baseline: 0)
5.1	People benefiting from increased rural investment (number)	NA	The project will benefit people in rural areas as it will serve vulnerable communities in tackling health issues of traditional cook stoves with improved air quality (reduction in smoke of 70%) and reducing use of biomass sources (fuel savings of 60%). It is also expected to save households' time and money, and free up time to develop alternative livelihoods or receive an education.
