

DEVELOPMENT COORDINATION MATRIX

Overview. The Asian Development Bank (ADB) is committed to strong development partner coordination in Mongolia. ADB participates in regular coordination fora at strategic, sectoral, and geographical levels. ADB leads engagement in several areas including food and agriculture; anti-money laundering; and other areas. The United Nations maintains an up-to-date database of development partner activities and chairs both a regular development partner coordination meeting (with the World Bank) and coronavirus disease (COVID-19) response activities (with the Office of the Deputy Prime Minister). In addition to these mechanisms, ADB promotes coordination through cofinancing, close consultation with development partners in project processing and implementation and inviting development partners to key project outreach events.
