




- CORRUPT PRACTICE: offering, giving, receiving, or soliciting, directly or indirectly, anything of value to influence improperly the actions of another party
- FRAUDULENT PRACTICE: any act or omission, including a misrepresentation, that knowingly or recklessly misleads, or attempts to mislead, a party to obtain a financial or other benefit or to avoid an obligation
- COERCIVE PRACTICE: impairing or harming, or threatening to impair or harm, directly or indirectly, any party or the property of the party to influence improperly the actions of another party
- COLLUSIVE PRACTICE: an arrangement between two or more parties designed to achieve an improper purpose, including influencing improperly the actions of another party
- ABUSE: theft, waste or improper use of assets related to ADB-related activity, either committed intentionally or through reckless disregard
- **CONFLICT OF INTEREST**: any situation in which a party has interests that could improperly influence that party's performance of official duties or responsibilities, contractual obligations, or compliance with applicable laws and regulations
- OBSTRUCTIVE PRACTICE: (a) deliberately destroying, falsifying, altering or concealing of evidence material to an ADB investigation; (b) making false statements to investigators in order to materially impede an ADB investigation; (c) failing to comply with requests to provide information, documents, or records in connection with an ADB investigation; (d) threatening, harassing or intimidating any party to prevent it from disclosing its knowledge of matters relevant to the investigation or from pursuing the investigation; or (e) materially impeding ADB's contractual rights of audit or access to information
