I live on village name Arubari in Kathmandu, Nepal where Melamchi Water Supply Project work is ongoing. This is a village of 200+ households and some 1200 people living on it. People of my community supported the pipe extension plan for which Project implementation division and the contractor promised to repair the road back to manageable condition. But it has been about the month the road left without proper repair keep people in isolation for basic right of mobility and access to health even. There was a medical emergency for which the patient had to be carried till the ambulance. We tried to contact all possible people for help who promised us earlier but none of them are demonstrating integrity on what they have promised. Contractor finished the work and left as the rainy season started and they are not in contact. Isn't it their duty to repair after they used it for their purpose? Should they be punished for forcing thousand of people to live miserable life.
