D. Project

Location	Village kheirpur malian on main sheikhupura mureedky road near lahore pakistan
Brief description	NTDC is acquiring 120 poor families land to build a 500kv grid station with the help of asian development bank Islamabad branch in Pakistan. NTDC firstly visited and approved a site but the owner of that land is powerful and used political resources and shifted the project to poor people land. NTDC has alternate suitable sites but they are destroying these 120 poor families.

⊕ E. Complaint:

What direct and material harm has the ADB-assisted project caused, or will likely cause, to the complainants?

1. the land being acquired by NTDC is fully fertile and almost 120 small scale farmer families are being affected while the former site was less fertile and only 2 big land owners were being affected. NTDC jointly with Adb changed that site and shifted to poor people's land.
2. the affected 120 families will lost their only source of income and will be unable to earn bread for single time.
3. many homes, dairy and fish farms and ancestral graveyard will be abolished.
4. The remaining land of other poor farmers will be flooded due to obstruction of grid station and flow of water in rainy season.
5. land being acquired have owners whose mutation (wrasti inteqal) has not been done from ancestors so the money will be distributed in wrong hands and the poor farmer will be left bare hand.
6. As it is non industrial area the construction of grid station and passage of high power wires will lessen the value of remaining land.
7. Not a single person want to give an inch of land to the NTDC or any other company as they will lost only mean of income.

8. many poor disable persons will be compelled to destruction and suffering as they will lost their source of living.
9. around 50 widows will be unable to support their families and will be left to death in poverty.
10. hundreds of kids will be deprived of basic education due to lack of money.

about 2 months ago i made a call in ADB Islamabad branch and told whole situation that ADB social safeguard team came to visit the site and asked people if they want to give land whole community shouted that they don't want to give their land as they will loss their only source to feed their children and if the NTDC take this land the future of the children of poor families will be destroyed they will not have enough money to feed and educate their kids. the ADB team assured that if the people are not willing they will not give fund to the NTDC. But inspite of this ADB let NTDC to continue their project process. after receiving my complaint sir Ehtesham khatak listened to my whole problem and give me a positive feedback and send his social safeguard team again to meet the sufferers but the head of social safeguard team Ashfaq khokhar came to village and shouted on poor people for protesting against NTDC and insisted whole time to let the problem resolved by NTDC itself who already want to snatch this land. both NTDC and ashfaq khokhar head of social safeguard want to implement section 5 which is a pakistani law to aquare land by power. neither NTDC nor ADB is doing anything for the suffering people. i am constantly sending complaints via emails and phone calls to ADB and NTDC but of no use.

we want that ADB ask the NTDC to change the site the alternate suggested sites are as follows:

1. Cheechoki hydal power station has nearby 120 acres of free land which other people are trying to grab. Hydal power station also has a large housing society which they are offering to NTDC to acquire.
2. Seikham lahore road is a new carpeted road which has almost 200-250 acres of free land of government alongside the main raod.
3. 7 acres back from the current site is the suitable land from technical point of view and the owners are large scale farmers and have no objection to give land.
