Notes to the Statement of Expenditures for the year ended 30 June 2015

1. Project Information

The implementing Agency for the Renewable Energy Development & Power Sector Rehabilitation Projects is the Electric Power Corporation (the Corporation). The Electric Power Corporation is a wholly owned Government Corporation in the generation and distribution of electricity through diesel generator, hydro power and solar.

The objective of the Renewable Energy Developments and Power Sector Rehabilitation Project (RED & PSRP) is to provide customer within the project area with higher access to higher share of electricity generated by hydropower. The Project consists of the following;

- a) Implementation of 5.50 MW of hydropower capacity in the Project area including;
 - i. Rehabilitating and reconnecting to the grid, three (3) small hydro plants (SHPs) on Upolu which was damaged by Cyclone Evan, ie) 1. Fale ole Fee plant, 2. Alaoa plant, 3. Samasoni plant, all on Upolu.
 - ii. Building and connecting to the existing grid the three (3) new small hydro plants, ie) 1. Faleseela plant on Upolu, 2. Fausaga/Tafitoala plant on Upolu and 3. Faleata (Vailoa Palauli) plant in Savaii.
- b) Operation and Maintenance (O & M) knowledge transfer program Provision of capacity development to the EPC and knowledge transfer program from consultancy components including;
 - i. Preparing Operation & Maintenance manuals for small hydro plants asset management, etc
 - ii. Providing training on theoretical and on-the-job training on hydropower assets management, etc.
- c) Efficient project implementation and management assist the EPC through Project Owners Engineers (POE) for efficient project implementation and management.

The project is fully grants funded and negotiations for further funding proposals is still on-going. All local tax and duty obligations related to this project are fully paid by the Electric Power Corporation as per normal ADB funding requirements. The foreign grant funding sources are ADB Special Operation Grants, Disaster Response Facility (under ADB Special Funds) and Multi Donor Clean Energy Grant Funds and Government of Samoa.

On 29th January 2015 the Corporation signed a Subsidiary Financing Agreement with the Government of Samoa for the Renewable Energy Development and Power Sector Rehabilitation Project. The total approved funding cost of the project is equivalent to USD\$19.21 million dollars. The financing components of the RED & PSR Project is summarized as follows;

As part of the agreement, it was also noted on section 9.01 that USD\$1m insurance compensation towards damages of the affected hydro during cyclone Evan recovered by the corporation to be used to contribute to this Hydro Project Renewable and Rehabilitation costs. This USD\$1m is the EPC counterpart towards the Hydro Renewable Projects.

2. Statement of significant accounting policies

The principal accounting policies applied in the preparation of these financial statements are set out below. These policies have been consistently applied to all years presented, unless otherwise stated.

a. Basis of preparation

The financial statements have been prepared on the historical cost basis unless otherwise stated. The principal accounting policies are stated to assist in a general understanding of these financial statements. The accounting basis used for this project follows the corporation basis which is accruals not cash.

b. Functional and presentation currency

Items included in the financial statements of the Corporation are measured using the currency of the primary economic environment in which the entity operates (the functional currency). The functional currency is the Samoan Tala (SAT).

c. Foreign currency transaction

The Asian Development Bank USD equivalent rate for Samoan Tala prevailing on the date of disbursements is used for all transactions in foreign currencies.

3. 154.910: Implementation Consultancies

i. Implementation Consultants

The Implementation consultancy works for Hydro Rehabilitating and Reconnecting Projects to the existing Grid was awarded to MWH NZ Limited. The contract is still ongoing and 42% of the contract price was paid as of 30th June 2015. Total implementing consultancy costs due and paid as of yearend was SAT\$774,990.31.

ii. Project Manager

The Project Manager for PMU PSEP Project is also the man in charge of the implementation and monitoring of the progress of this new project. The Project Manager's contract was formed and is funded under PSEP project and therefore his full cost is also reported under the same project instead.

4. 154.910: Refurbishments of Small Hydro Plants

This project is specifically for the refurbishment, rebuilding and reconnecting of the three small Hydro Plants which were damaged during Cyclone Evan in 2012. The projects were just started early 2015 with surveying works while its core project constructions and refurbishment works is still in tendering process. The surveying working consists of the following field of services and works as committed during the financial year ended 30th June 2015.

i. Survey works on damaged Small Hydro Plants

Surveys for three damaged Hydro Power plants were awarded as listed below;

All three stations surveying works were completed and fully paid within the financial year. Total cost for survey works of SAT\$102,310.00 have SAT\$88,965.22 funded from grants and SAT\$13,344.78 was paid by EPC for local tax on services (Vagst).

ii. Maintenance and Clearance Constructions of Small Hydro Plants

The Alaoa hydro plant clearance works was awarded to Faaolataga Lawn Maintenance Service for clearance of Alaoa Headrace (Eastern canal). Contract was completed and 90% was claimed during the financial year while 10% retention to be released in FY15/16. Total amount due and paid consist of SAT\$48,271.30 funded from grants and SAT\$7,240.70 to be paid by EPC for local tax of 15% Vagst.

iii. Refurbishments of Small Hydro Plants

The Hydro generators Inspection and testing contract was awarded to Pacific Engineering Projects Ltd. This is for two (2) hydro generators at Samasoni Hydro Plant and one (1) at Fale ole Fee Hydro Plant which was completed and fully paid in FY14/15 period. Total cost of this specific project in equivalent Samoan Tala is SAT\$38,005.44.

5. 154.910: Rehabilitation and Construction of three (3) new Small Hydro Plants

This project is specifically for the developments of three (3) new Small Hydro Plants, one (1) at Faleeata (Vailoa Palauli) in Savaii and two (2) in Upolu, Faleseela & Fausaga/Tafitoala. The project includes building and connecting of three (3) new hydro plants to the existing Grid. The building and construction works is still in tendering process but surveying works was completed during FY14/15 and have fully paid as well. The Survey works is summarized as follows;

10. RED PSRP Project Subsequent Events

As at 30th June 2015, the following events are at early stage of tendering processes and designing under RED PSRP Project;

- Rehabilitation Project for (3) three damaged Hydro (Alaoa, Fale ole Fee & Samasoni).
 The consultancy (MWH) has already submitted the technical evaluation reports for these small hydro projects and was approved by PMU. Therefore tender for rehabilitations of all three damage hydro was open for bidding since May 2015 and close in July 2015.
- Constructions Project of four (4) new small hydro

 The consultancy (MWH) is finalizing the technical evaluation report for PMU review and acceptance. The tender procurement process is also waiting on the consultant's approve drawing and is also schedule to commence in FY15/16 period.
