PROJECT AGREEMENT

PROJECT AGREEMENT dated 19 January 2006 between ASIAN DEVELOPMENT BANK ("ADB") and VIETNAM EXPRESSWAY CORPORATION ("VEC").

WHEREAS

(A) by a Loan Agreement of even date herewith between the Socialist Republic of Viet Nam (the "Borrower") and ADB, ADB has agreed to make to the Borrower a loan in various currencies equivalent to four million two hundred and nine thousand Special Drawing Rights (SDR 4,209,000) on the terms and conditions set forth in the Loan Agreement, but only on condition that the proceeds of the Loan be made available to VEC and that VEC agree to undertake certain obligations towards ADB as set forth in this Project Agreement; and

(B) VEC, in consideration of ADB entering into the Loan Agreement with the Borrower, has agreed to undertake the obligations set forth in this Project Agreement;

NOW THEREFORE the parties agree as follows:

ARTICLE I

Definitions

Section 1.01. Wherever used in this Project Agreement, unless the context otherwise requires, the terms defined in the Loan Agreement and in the Loan Regulations (as so defined) have the respective meanings therein set forth.

ARTICLE II

Particular Covenants

Section 2.01. (a) VEC shall carry out the Technical Assistance with due diligence and efficiency, and in conformity with sound administrative, financial, engineering, environmental and highway practices.

(b) In the carrying out of the Technical Assistance and operation of the Technical Assistance facilities, VEC shall perform all obligations set forth in the Loan Agreement to the extent that they are applicable to VEC.

Section 2.02. VEC shall make available, promptly as needed, the funds, facilities, services, equipment, and other resources which are required, in addition to the proceeds of the Loan, for the carrying out of the Technical Assistance.

Section 2.03. (a) In the carrying out of the Technical Assistance, VEC shall employ competent and qualified consultants and contractors, acceptable to ADB, to an extent and upon terms and conditions satisfactory to ADB.

(b) Except as ADB may otherwise agree, all goods and services to be financed out of the proceeds of the Loan shall be procured in accordance with the provisions of Schedule 4 and Schedule 5 to the Loan Agreement. ADB may refuse to finance a contract where goods or services have not been procured under procedures substantially in accordance with those agreed between the Borrower and ADB or where the terms and conditions of the contract are not satisfactory to ADB.

Section 2.04. VEC shall carry out the Technical Assistance in accordance with plans, design standards, specifications, work schedules and construction methods acceptable to ADB. VEC shall furnish, or cause to be furnished, to ADB, promptly after their preparation, such plans, design standards, specifications and work schedules, and any material modifications subsequently made therein, in such detail as ADB shall reasonably request.

Section 2.05. (a) VEC shall take out and maintain with responsible insurers, or make other arrangements satisfactory to ADB for, insurance of Technical Assistance facilities to such extent and against such risks and in such amounts as shall be consistent with sound practice.

(b) Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, VEC undertakes to insure, or cause to be insured, the goods to be imported for the Technical Assistance and to be financed out of the proceeds of the Loan against hazards incident to the acquisition, transportation and delivery thereof to the place of use or installation, and for such insurance any indemnity shall be payable in a currency freely usable to replace or repair such goods.

Section 2.06. VEC shall maintain, or cause to be maintained, records and accounts adequate to identify the goods and services and other items of expenditure financed out of the proceeds of the Loan, to disclose the use thereof in the Technical Assistance, to record the progress of the Technical Assistance (including the cost thereof) and to reflect, in accordance with consistently maintained sound accounting principles, its operations and financial condition.

Section 2.07. (a) ADB and VEC shall cooperate fully to ensure that the purposes of the Loan will be accomplished.

(b) VEC shall promptly inform ADB of any condition which interferes with, or threatens to interfere with, the progress of the Technical Assistance, the performance of its obligations under this Project Agreement or the accomplishment of the purposes of the Loan.

(c) ADB and VEC shall from time to time, at the request of either party, exchange views through their representatives with regard to any matters relating to the Technical Assistance, VEC and the Loan.

Section 2.08. (a) VEC shall furnish to ADB all such reports and information as ADB shall reasonably request concerning (i) the Loan and the expenditure of the proceeds thereof; (ii) the goods and services and other items of expenditure financed out of such proceeds; (iii) the Technical Assistance; (iv) the

administration, operations and financial condition of VEC as is relevant to the Technical Assistance; and (v) any other matters relating to the purposes of the Loan.

(b) Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, VEC shall furnish to ADB monthly reports on the execution of the Technical Assistance and on the operation and management of the Technical Assistance facilities. Such reports shall be submitted in such form and in such detail and within such a period as ADB shall reasonably request, and shall indicate, among other things, progress made and problems encountered during the month under review, steps taken or proposed to be taken to remedy these problems, and proposed program of activities and expected progress during the following month.

(c) Promptly after physical completion of the Technical Assistance, but in any event not later than three (3) months thereafter or such later date as ADB may agree for this purpose, VEC shall prepare and furnish to ADB a report, in such form and in such detail as ADB shall reasonably request, on the execution and initial operation of the Technical Assistance, including its cost, the performance by VEC of its obligations under this Project Agreement and the accomplishment of the purposes of the Loan.

Section 2.09. (a) VEC shall (i) maintain separate accounts for the Technical Assistance and for its overall operations; (ii) have such accounts and related financial statements (balance sheet, statement of income and expenses, and related statements) audited annually, in accordance with appropriate auditing standards consistently applied, by independent auditors whose qualifications, experience and terms of reference are acceptable to ADB; and (iii) furnish to ADB, promptly after their preparation but in any event not later than 6 months after the close of the fiscal year to which they relate, certified copies of such audited accounts and financial statements and the report of the auditors relating thereto (including the auditors' opinion on the use of the Loan proceeds and compliance with the financial covenants of the Loan Agreement as well as on the use of the procedures for imprest account/statement of expenditures), all in the English language. VEC shall furnish to ADB such further information concerning such accounts and financial statements and the audit thereof as ADB shall from time to time reasonably request.

(b) VEC shall enable ADB, upon ADB's request, to discuss VEC's financial statements and its financial affairs from time to time with the auditors, appointed by VEC pursuant to Section 2.09(a) hereabove, and shall authorize and require any representative of such auditors to participate in any such discussions requested by ADB, provided that any such discussion shall be conducted only in the presence of an authorized officer of VEC unless VEC shall otherwise agree.

Section 2.10. VEC shall enable ADB's representatives to inspect the Technical Assistance, the goods financed out of the proceeds of the Loan, all other sites, works, properties and equipment of VEC, and any relevant records and documents.

Section 2.11. (a) VEC shall, promptly as required, take all action within its powers to maintain its corporate existence, to carry on its operations, and to acquire, maintain and renew all rights, properties, powers, privileges and franchises which are necessary in the carrying out of the Technical Assistance or in the conduct of its business.

(b) VEC shall at all times conduct its business in accordance with sound administrative, financial, environmental and highway practices, and under the supervision of competent and experienced management and personnel.

(c) VEC shall at all times operate and maintain its sites, equipment and other property, and from time to time, promptly as needed, make all necessary repairs and renewals thereof, all in accordance with sound administrative, financial, engineering, environmental, highway and maintenance and operational practices.

Section 2.12. Except as ADB may otherwise agree, VEC shall not sell, lease or otherwise dispose of any of its assets which shall be required for the efficient carrying on of its operations or the disposal of which may prejudice its ability to perform satisfactorily any of its obligations under this Project Agreement.

Section 2.13. Except as ADB may otherwise agree, VEC shall apply the proceeds of the Loan to the financing of expenditures on the Technical Assistance in accordance with the provisions of the Loan Agreement and this Project Agreement, and shall ensure that all goods and services financed out of such proceeds are used exclusively in the carrying out of the Technical Assistance.

Section 2.14. Except as ADB may otherwise agree, VEC shall duly perform all its obligations under the this Project Agreement, and shall not take, or concur in, any action which would have the effect of assigning, amending, abrogating or waiving any rights or obligations of the parties under this Project Agreement.

Section 2.15. VEC shall promptly notify ADB of any proposal to amend, suspend or repeal any provision of its Charter and shall afford ADB an adequate opportunity to comment on such proposal prior to taking any action thereon.

ARTICLE III

Effective Date; Termination

Section 3.01. This Project Agreement shall come into force and effect on the date on which the Loan Agreement shall come into force and effect. ADB shall promptly notify VEC of such date.

Section 3.02. All the provisions of this Project Agreement shall continue in full force and effect notwithstanding any cancellation or suspension under the Loan Agreement.

ARTICLE IV

Miscellaneous

Section 4.01. Any notice or request required or permitted to be given or made under this Project Agreement and any agreement between the parties contemplated by this Project Agreement shall be in writing. Such notice or request shall be deemed to have been duly given or made when it shall be delivered by hand or by mail, telegram, cable, telex, facsimile or radiogram to the party to which it is required or permitted to be given or made at its address hereinafter specified, or at such other address as such party shall have designated by notice to the party giving such notice or making such request. Section 4.02. (a) Any action required or permitted to be taken, and any documents required or permitted to be executed, under this Project Agreement or under Section 6.01 of the Loan Agreement by or on behalf of VEC may be taken or executed by its Chairman or by such other person or persons as he/she shall so designate in writing notified to ADB.

(b) VEC shall furnish to ADB sufficient evidence of the authority of each person who will act under paragraph (a) of this Section, together with the authenticated specimen signature of each such person.

Section 4.03. No delay in exercising, or omission to exercise, any right, power or remedy accruing to either party under this Project Agreement upon any default shall impair any such right, power or remedy or be construed to be a waiver thereof or an acquiescence in such default; nor shall the action of such party in respect of any default, or any acquiescence in any default, affect or impair any right, power or remedy of such party in respect of any other or subsequent default.
