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## **1 INTRODUCTION**

1. This due diligence report investigates and document the issues associated with Resettlement Plan (RP) implementation of Garma-Nele Road during Decentralized Rural Infrastructure Livelihood Project (DRILP). It has been prepared by resettlement team of Central Implementation Support Consultant (CISC) lead by Resettlement Advisor in coordination with District Implementation Support Consultant (DISC), District Technical Office (DTO) and District Project Office (DPO) of DRILP-AF.
2. The objective of preparing due diligence report is to verify progress of Resettlement Plan implementation such as compensation payment, restoration of public and private infrastructure, review the consultation and disclosure process, grievance redress mechanism and restoration of livelihood of the affected person in compliance with ADB's Safeguard Policy Statement (SPS) 2009, and Government of Nepal (GoN) Land Acquisition Act 1977. It suggests appropriate mitigation measures to address the resettlement issues aroused during RP implementation and propose suitable corrective action plan. It also documents the implementation progress status and commits to fulfill all the outstanding activities within provided time

## **2 BACKGROUND OF THE SUBPROJECT**

3. The total length of Garma-Nele Road is 27.1 km but under DRILP the construction was carried out and Resettlement Plan was approved up to 9.6 km. There are some remaining civil works such as cross drainage, site drain, and soling at high grade need to be built to make road all weather standards which will be undertaken in DRILP-AF.
4. The Garma-Nele Road subproject in Solukhumbu District is located in south east part of Solukhumbu district, Sagarmatha zone at Eastern Development region of Nepal. The subproject is part of Garma-Nele Budhidanda section, it starts at Jorbuddha of Garma VDC and ends at Jogara of Nele VDC and targets to link district headquarter, Phaplu. The Kagil airport is adjacent with these two VDCs and weekly flight is accessible from and to Kathmandu. Nele Bazar is biggest market of South-East part of Solukhumbu district. The due diligence report is prepared up to 9.6 km section.

## **3 FINDINGS**

### **3.1 Background of Approved Resettlement Plan**

5. The Resettlement Plan (RP) of Garma-Nele road subproject was approved by ADB on 8 April 2010, prepared by the DDC with support of CISC. The RP covered resettlement scope of Garma-Nele under DRILP. While preparing the RP the socio-economic survey investigated socio-economic condition of the project affected

households, assessed the losses, details the measures and prepared plans to mitigate adverse impact on the affected people residing along the alignment.

6. According to Garma-Nele road subproject verification report there is no change in the affected household's plots. Of the total 64% of the compensation has been paid and the mitigation measures proposed in approved resettlement plan have been fully addressed. For this subproject updated RP is not required because the approved RP is sufficient to address the requirement of DRILP AF, therefore due diligence is prepared to fulfill the outstanding work as per DRILP-AF Resettlement Framework.
7. The approved RP showed that 3.57 ha of private land, 341 trees and 32 fruit trees need to be acquired from 117 households for the road construction. Among the total 117 affected households 44 are interviewed and 73 are absentees. The Poverty analysis of the 44 households indicated that 34 of the households fall below the district poverty level and 10 households are eligible for donation. The project land donation criteria were disclosed with each affected households and the land donation was accepted only those households if they are eligible for donation. The 34 households falling below the district poverty level were compensated by the project. In case of 73 absentee households the project has allocated NRs 27,15,122.49, once these owners will come in contact the compensation will be delivered. Summary of losses incurred along the alignment according to approved RP is under Table 1.

8. After the approval of the RP DDC had started distribution of compensation, deed transfer and implementation of proposed trainings. The safeguard requirements were met during the whole RP preparation and implementation process. Three formal meetings and several informal meetings were conducted with community and affected households at different dates and venues during socio-economic survey and resettlement plan preparation in 2010. The consultation included discussion about project benefits, entitlement matrix, land acquisition and donation procedures. Communities were well informed that road construction could reduce their walking time, enhance business opportunities and thereby reduce seasonal migration to India and gulf country. The safeguard requirements as per RP and their present status are presented in following table 2.

### 3.2 Summary of losses and Compensation Disbursement Status

9. **Land:** The allocated land compensation for 34 households falling below the district poverty level is NRs. 9, 56,316.33. Of the total allocated amount NRs. 4, 99,492.68 (52 percent) has already been disbursed. The remaining NRs. 4, 56,823.65 of 14 households yet to be paid, as these households are reluctant to come to the district headquarter because they hold nominal amount and few are out of the district. Therefore, transportation and other allowances have been offered to them in order to collect the compensation. In addition, the district team is being constantly involved in communicating the households for compensation payment.
10. **Private and Fruit Trees:** NRs. 86,521.64 was decided by CDC and 100% compensation has been paid.
11. **Standing Crops:** NRs. 2, 34,942.09 was decided by CDC and 100% compensation has been paid.
12. **Deed Transfer:** Out of total 117 households 66 households (56 percent) ownership has been transferred. Based on district report majority of the land owners are living abroad which is the main reason of the delayed in deed transfer. Further, the DDC has been advised to verify the real status of the delay and precede the deed transfer work on the target action plan.
13. **Provision for absentee households:** The project has allocated NRs. 27, 15,122.49 for the absentee households in the approved RP and DDC has made commitment to pay compensation for all 73 households. Based on DDC source the amount is still remain in DDC project fund and will be provided after they come in contact. However, DDC has not made any significant effort to reach these owners except informing

them through Local FM. Therefore, DDC has advised to initiate honest effort through their relatives and allocate sufficient budget to gear up the deed transfer work efficiently.

14. The below table 3 shows the summary of RP implementation. Overall 64 percent compensation payment has been completed; Land compensation 52 percent paid, Trees and fruits compensation 100 percent completed, standing crops 100 percent completed and deed transfer 56 percent completed.

### 3.3 Life Skill Training

15. Total 6 life skill trainings were completed though 12 trainings were proposed in the approved RP. As reported by the district no further training is required in this section because all participants were covered.
16. Life skill trainings organized for the affected families are Radio/TV/Mobile Maintenance, Motor Driving, Trekking Guide, Hotel Management and hospitality, Basic Computer Training, Livestock rearing and Off-Season Vegetable Farming. The completed trainings benefitted 173 participants from the affected families

## 4 SCOPE OF SUBPROJECT IN DRILP-AF

### 4.1 Completion of Outstanding Activities

17. **Compensation Disbursement:** In the approved RP NRs. 10, 428, 37.97 were allocated for compensation. Later, NRs 2, 34,942.09 were included for crop compensation and the compensation was amended to NRs. 12, 77,780.06. Of the total revised compensation amount NRs 8, 20,956.41 has been already been paid and NRs. 4, 56,823.65 is left. Hence, the compensation of crops, fruits and tress has been fully disbursed and the left compensation amount has been reserved in DDC. The DDC solukhumbhu has commitment to disburse all the outstanding activities before commencement of civil works.
18. The report shows that 14 affected households are yet to be paid. Hence, DDC has suggested providing cost of time loss and traveling expenses to come and collect compensation. DDC/DPO has been trying to reach these APs through their relatives and FM radios. The progress status of the reserve fund will be documented in regular progress report of CISC and during verification reporting
19. **Civil Works:** Construction of 9.6 km Garma-Nele was under taken in DRILP and has been partially completed. DRILP-AF propose same section in his scope to carry out remaining civil works such as cross drainage, site drain, and soling at high grade to make road all weather standards.

## 5 DRILP AF REQUIREMENTS

20. The Resettlement Framework (RF) of DRILP AF states that land acquisition and resettlement activities of the affected families need to be completed before starting the civil work whereas deed transfer and livelihood restoration trainings can continue and be completed even after civil works has begun. In addition, formation of District Level Resettlement Coordination Committee (DLRCC), District Grievance Redress Committee (GRC) and safeguard desk need to be established at each district. DLRCC and GRC have been formed in Solukhumbu with present district authorities.
21. **Meeting Minute:** the minute dated 31 August 2012 in DDC Solukhumbu has formed of 13-membered DLRCC and 10-membered GRC. The letters sent by DDC have been annexed and the committee name list is given under boxes.

22. District Project Office (DPO) under District Technical Office (DTO) Engineer Mr. Santosh Kumar Yadav has been appointed for coordinating the safeguard activities. Letter from DDC has been annexed.

## 6 CONCLUSION AND FURTHER ACTION

23. The finding of this due diligence report concludes that the compensation disbursement for the crops and fruits has been 100 percent completed. The land compensation for 14 households yet to be paid and the deed transfer of 51 households is yet to be done. The district team is constantly involved in communicating these households for compensation payment and deed transfer. The DDC Solukhumbu has committed the following action plan to accomplish the outstanding issues under table 4.
24. Of the 12 proposed life skills training in the RP 6 training has been completed covering all the affected households thus further training is not required for Garma-Nele section.
