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## I. BACK GROUND

### 1.1. Project Overview

1. Thua Thien Hue is a province in the North Central Coast region of Vietnam, approximately in the centre of the country. It borders Quang Tri Province to the north and Da Nang City to the south, Laos to the west and the East Vietnam Sea to the east. The province has 128 km of coastline, 22,000 ha of lagoons and over 200,000 ha of forest. There is an extensive complex of imperial tombs and temples in Thua Thien Hue.

2. The improvement in the water supply system of Thua Thien Hue Province would support social, economic and environmental development of the Province, supporting trade and commerce, facilitating employment generation, and raising income levels in the project component areas and the Province as a whole. The Vietnam Water Sector Investment Program will support women and children as well as address full cost recovery of tariffs to achieve long term financial sustainability of the improvements.

3. The water supply and sanitation tranche-2 Subproject located in Thua Thien Hue Province (Subproject) is one of the six tranche-2 Subprojects of the Viet Nam Water Sector Investment Program to be implemented under the Loan Agreement No. 2961 - VIE (SF) between the Socialist Republic of Vietnam (GoV) and the Asian Development Bank (ADB).

4. The original components of Thua Thien Hue Water Supply Joint Stock Company (HueWACO), among other water supply companies (WSCs) under the Vietnam Water Sector Investment Program are; (i) constructing a WTP approximately 8,000 m<sup>3</sup>/day; (ii) constructing an approximately 40 km transmission pipeline D400-1,200; and (iii) constructing approximately 378 km distribution pipeline D40-355.1

### Project component

5. Installing about 700 km of D40-D1200 transmission and distribution pipelines in 5 water supply areas of Phong Dien, Tu Ha, Loc An, Loc Bon and Hue City. Of which: Ductile iron pipes (D400-1200): 34.3 km and HDPE pipe (D40-450): 665.7 km.

6. The current investment plan will cover areas 1-5:

- ✓ Area 1: Phong Dien water supply area (150 km pipeline, D50-D500)
- ✓ Area 2: Tu Ha water supply area (90 km pipeline, D50-D500)

- ✓ Area 3: Water supply area of Hue city and surrounding areas (140 km of pipeline, D50-D1200)
- ✓ Area 4: Loc Bon water supply area (230 km pipeline, D50-D600)
- ✓ Area 5: Loc An water supply (100 km pipeline, D50-D400)

### **Packages and progress of work**

7. The 3 works packages have been awarded and the construction has started, as described below:

- ✓ Package HUE-CW03: Supply and installation of ductile iron pipes and accessories with diameters from D400-D1200. Total: 17 routes, L=34.3 km

The package was implemented by Bach Dang Construction Corporation – JSC. on August 9, 2017. Notice to commence the works on June 20, 2018 and ended on October 30, 2019.

- ✓ Package HUE-CW05: Supply and installation of HDPE pipes and accessories at Phong Dien, Tu Ha and Hue City. Total: 93 routes, L=310.6 km

The package was implemented by Joint Venture of Dai Phu Thinh - Southern Construction Company. The contract was signed on April 10, 2018. Notice to commence the works on April 24, 2018 and ended on August 30, 2019.

- ✓ Package HUE-CW06: Supply and installation of HDPE pipes and fittings in Loc An and Loc Bon areas. Total: 49 routes, L=337.3 km

The package was implemented by Vietnam Environment and Water Investment Corporation – JSC. The contract was signed on March 8, 2018. Notice to commence the works on April 10, 2018 and ended on August 30, 2019.

### **1.2. Objectives of the Subproject**

8. The implementation of the Project will (a) increase coverage in the service area of the water supply companies (WSCs); (b) improve WSCs' business planning, financial management and asset management; and (c) reduce non-revenue water, through the implementation of prepared sub-projects and preparation of similar sub-projects for financing.

### **1.3. Rational of this report**

9. The construction phase of Thua Thien Hue Water Supply Project started since August 9, 2017 and finished on October 30, 2019, including 03 packages HUE-CW03, HUE-CW05 and HUE-CW06. During the construction phase, there were effects that were not anticipated. These impacts were also addressed as they arose. That is reason for preparation of the Due Diligence

report for the project. The DDR is made for 3 packages of CW03, CW05 and CW06 when the compensation and support for assets and structures affected by the 3 packages have been completed.

#### **1.4. Objectives and methodology of Due diligence report**

10. The purpose of this DDR is to review and re-evaluate the resettlement activities carried out within the project scope in line with project resettlement framework, providing the conclusion and recommendations for those activities in the incoming stage of the project. The DDR report is prepared to consider (i) the process of compensation and site clearance for affected people complies with the laws and regulations of the Vietnamese government on compensation and site clearance. according to the law; (ii) to review complaints and grievances in the process of compensation and site clearance; (iii) to review along the pipelines (on field), to verify whether land or assets on land will be acquired within the scope of construction; (iv) to ensure there are no existing issues related to resettlement, site clearance and compensation of the project to meet the requirements of ADB during the preparation of this DDR report; (v) to ensure that there are no potential risks on compensation and site clearance in accordance with the funder regulations.

11. During the preparation of DDR, consultant and PMU has started the survey in September and October 2019, with the following tasks: (i) Collecting the available information/document: e.g. checking the detail measurement survey (DMS), legal documents of project compensation and resettlement; (ii) Consultation and group discussion with related parties and AHs; (iii) quantitative survey by questionnaire interviewing affected households within the project scope; and (iv) field visit and observations with the stakeholders.

12. The methods of implementation used for DDR reporting include the following qualitative and quantitative methods:

*a. Collecting available information / documents: Reviewing DMS and legal documents related to compensation and resettlement of subprojects*

13. The consultant has collected, analyzed and reviewed documents related to measurement and inventory (DMS), compensation, price support and dossier of compensation unit price calculation stored at the PMU of Thua Thien Hue to find out the number of affected households / units; impact types; unit prices used in calculating compensation as well as compensation and site clearance plans; and amount of compensation and cash assistance paid; and to disclose information and conduct community consultations as well as to collect complaints of affected households / units (if any). Results showed that there were 378 AHs of 3 bidding packages with 100% of households compensated. Each household has a calculation table with detailed



compensation rates for affected assets and structures and has signed a money receipt (see details in the appendix of the Table of Compensation Costs for crops and structures).

*b. Consultation and focus group discussion with affected households and relevant agencies*

14. Public consultation is conducted by the PMU in collaboration with the consultant. Consultations include the PMU's representatives, social consultants, representatives of local authorities (Chairman / Vice Chairman of People's Committee of wards / communes, cadastres, women's unions, village heads), representatives of affected households, construction supervision consultants, and the construction contractors of all 3 packages. Because the subproject does not have a compensation / site clearance committee, a measurement, inventory and compensation planning are conducted by the PMU in coordination with local authorities, construction supervision consultants and affected households. Consultation with the parties is aimed to obtain and verify information regarding the site clearance process, implementation status, and achieved results.

15. About consultation: The consultant carried out a total of 16 consultations during the construction design phase (April 2017 with 6 meetings) and the construction phase (July 2019 with 10 meetings) with 268 participants (123 female and 145 male) on Introduction of the project size, location, objectives and benefits from having clean water; The effects of borrowing land for construction and the effects of the construction; Compensation policy, compensation implementation process, compensation unit price and other relevant issues.

16. During the preparation of DDR, the consultant was conducted with a survey for 91/378 AHs on the level of satisfaction with the applicable compensation price.

(See details in the **Annex 1+2** of the Minutes of consultation meetings)

**c. Questionnaire survey for affected households**

17. The PMU has conducted a questionnaire survey and consultation with 91/378 affected households accounting for 24.1% of the affected households in 14 communes in 6 districts / towns / city of all 3 bidding packages, of which CW03 had 22 /56 AHs, accounting for 39.3%, CW05 had 33/177, accounting for 18.6% and CW06 had 36/145 AHs, accounting for 24.8%. Among 91 surveyed households, there are 03 vulnerable households, which are poor households.

18. The objective of the consultation with the affected households through the questionnaire survey is to find out the life and economy of the households, the degree of impact on them, and the project's impacts on their lives; current living standards, income, livelihoods, complaints (if any) related to the subproject; process of compensation and support level of the subproject; and people's current wishes for the subproject. (See the **annex 3** for Questionnaire survey)

**d. Field visits, observations, inspections and reviews on the site**

19. The consultant has been together with the PMU, representatives of local authorities, and contractor representatives to visit the field of work items implemented by the project. At the time of the survey, all 3 packages are about to be completed, the work progress is about 90%. The routes have completed the work of site return which has been implemented and does not affect the life and travel of households. There are still a few small routes that are completing the work of digging and installing the distribution pipeline to each household.

#### **e. Collected documents**

20. The consultant worked with the PMU to collect legal documents and documents related to compensation and site clearance and others including:

- Decision approving the design and construction drawing;
- Summary of data related to inventory and measurement;
- List of 378 affected households of 3 bidding packages;
- A record identifying the current situation of crops and architectural objects for the compensation for each household;
- Calculation table of compensation cost for each household;
- Consultation minutes;
- Data collected on socio-economic information of communes / wards in the project area;
- Decision No. 68/2015/QD-UBND of Thua Thien Hue province dated December 22, 2015 on “Promulgating unit prices of houses, constructions, architectural objects and graves as a basis for determining the value of compensation and support when the Government acquires land belonging to Thua Thien Hue province”
- Decision No. 82/2017/QD-UBND of Thua Thien Hue dated September 22, 2017 on “Promulgating unit prices for plants and livestock as a basis for determining the value of compensation and support when the Government acquires land belonging to Thua Thien Hue province”.

21. Time for consultation / survey implementation were in September and October 2019.

#### **1.5. Scope of impacts**

22. As the subproject is mainly constructing pipelines on public land (sidewalks, state-owned fields, people's gardens (negligible), etc.), there is no permanent land acquisition and no resettlement residence required. Consultation process with organizations and households showed that the extent and nature of impact are only temporary. Therefore, the resettlement activities of the Project such as DMS, compensation plans, etc. are all implemented by Thua Thien

Hue Water Supply Joint Stock Company (the PMU) and no specialized compensation / land clearance committee is established.

23. The process of identifying, measuring and inventorying assets and affected architectural objects. In general, the PMU has no difficulty in compensation and support for the AHs because the PMU has much experience in implementing this work.

24. About the vulnerable households affected by the project, during the inventory of losses based on the design drawing, there were 28 vulnerable households identified, including: 11 poor households, 14 under preferential treatment policy households, 2 disabled-headed households, 1 household headed by the elderly (1-2 people) / a single person without his/her children support. However, during the construction phase, the pipelines have been relocated (by moving the pipeline routes about 1-2m) to avoid the actual impact on AHs. As the result, 25/28 vulnerable households (VHs) received compensation but have no actual impact on their assets (the survey form for AHs without actual impacts is attached in Annex 9). Therefore, PMU defined that the total number of vulnerable households with actual impacts by the project is 03 households, as the basis for the assistance for vulnerable households.

25. **No. of affected households:** No households are affected by permanent land acquisition. There were 378 temporary affected households (1,858 Aps) during the construction process. Among 378 AHs, CW03 package included 56 households (accounting for 14.8%) and CW05 included 177 households (46.8%) and CW06 included 145 households (accounting for 38.4%). 378 affected households in 39 wards / towns / towns of 7 districts / towns / city in the project as follows.

26. **Vulnerable households:** 03 households of vulnerable, they are poor households in An Hoa ward (1 household), Quang Loi commune (1 household), Huong Ho Ward (1 household). No ethnic minority households were affected.

27. **Affected trees, crops and architectural objects include** 575 fruit trees, 16,932 timber trees, 85,369.3 m<sup>2</sup> of cash crops, and 1,481.85 (m / m<sup>2</sup> / m<sup>3</sup>) architectural objects affected, such as yard, cement foundation, 1 (m / m<sup>2</sup> / m<sup>3</sup>) fence and 38 auxiliary structures affected. The affected assets of AHs are located on agricultural land (land for annual crops, including rice land, other annual crops, production forest land and garden), these lands were restored after construction. No houses was affected.

29. No business and trading households were temporarily affected during the construction process. There were no ethnic minority households, graves, historical sites, temples, and agencies / organizations / businesses / communities affected by the project.

## II. KEY FINDINGS

### 2.1. Information Disclosure and consultation

30. From the beginning of the project implementation until the DDR report implementation to date, during the project, information disclosure and consultation / interview with 1,061 people of which 632 men (accounting for 59.57%) and 429 women (accounting for 40.43%) were carried out. As follows:

31. Most consultations showed that households and local authorities were very supportive of the project implementation and it needed to be implemented quickly so as not to affect traveling and farming of people. There were also some ideas that the compensation for crops was low, but the impacts are minor, subproject only affected a small part of their land so it did not disturb the life and income of the households. Thus, the households were willing to support the project and receive compensation and support as prescribed. Up to now 100% of the interviewed households are satisfied with the project because they realized that clean water benefits their families and communities and the degree of impact is insignificant.

## 2.2. Procedure and evaluation of inventory, compensation payment

32. The project has a total pipeline of nearly 700km (158 routes) spreading over 80 wards and communes. Thus, the site clearance has been carried out sequentially and according to the construction schedule of each route. About 2 months before starting the construction, the measurement and inventory work has been carried out. In particular, the PMU has collaborated

with the local authorities where the pipeline passes through, the monitoring consultants and the households affected by the project to measure, inventory, and identify assets of the affected households, as well as to agree on the compensation plan and unit price based on the consent of the affected households and make payments to the affected households within 7 days from the time when the measurement and inventory were agreed. **Annex 8** present the sample of minute on inventory and compensation plan for 01 AH.

33. The payment period for 378 affected households was conducted from March 2018 to August 2019. Process of implementation is summarized in table below:.

34. Policies to be applied to payment for households: The payment for affected households by the project is applied according to the Decision No. 68/2015 and Decision No. 82/2017. Specifically, as follows:

- Decision No. 82/2017/QD-UBND of Thua Thien Hue dated September 22, 2017 on “Promulgating unit prices for plants and livestock as a basis for determining the value of compensation and support when the Government acquires land belonging to Thua Thien Hue province”.

35. **Cost of compensation and resettlement assistance:** The total amount of compensation and support paid for 378 households was **VND 1,001,418,863**. This amount has been paid to households in 8 installments. Starting in April 2018 and ending in October 2019. Detail by package as follow

36. By conducting the inventory of losses, PMU has defined that there are 378 households with affected assets on land under the project, in which 03 households are vulnerable households. All of affected households received the compensation for their affected assets. According to the

Resettlement Framework of the project, supports for vulnerable households are provided for households whom have no permanent losses of land. Detail in table below:

37. The payment to vulnerable AHs was conducted during DDR preparation. Cash receipts of additional supports for 03 vulnerable households are attached in Annex 9.

38. At the time of making DDR report, through consultations, the households also did not complain about the compensation unit price applied by the project. 92.3% (83/91 households) of the surveyed households agreed with the compensation price while the rest commented that if the unit price applied was higher, they would be more satisfied. However, due the benefit of project to the community and the impact on the households is minor so 100% of the households agree with the project implementation.

39. **Livelihood restoration program:** Not applied in the project because the households were slightly / temporarily affected during the construction process and the project did not affect the household's income and livelihood.

### 2.3. Institutional arrangement

40. PMU in cooperation with the ward / commune authorities where the pipelines run through and related parties to implement the DMS, compensation payment and site clearance and monitoring until project completion

41. The CPC will assist the PMU in compensation payment and site clearance. Specifically, the CPC will be responsible for the following:

- (i) To coordinate with local and district mass organizations to mobilize those who will receive compensation and support the settlement policy under the approved compensation and site clearance plan.
- (ii) To coordinate with the PMU and working group to disseminate the reasons for compensation and site clearance to households whose land is affected;

- (iii) Communal officials are assigned to assist the PMU to update the DMS and implement payment activities;
- (iv) To identify affected trees, crops and structure objects for households;
- (v) To sign compensation arrangements with households;
- (vi) To assist in resolving complaints; and
- (vii) To actively participate in all resettlement activities.

## 2.4. Grievance Redress Mechanism

42. During the implementation, three affected households reported that their wet rice fields were not able to be cultivated after being returned. All are under Package CW05.

43. The survey results showed that the income from the affected parts/land is 1.5% ~ 6% / month compared to the total income of the household. It is insignificant.

44. After the site was returned by the contractor, 3 affected households did not want the PMU or the contractor to carry out the land improvement. Instead, they want to carry out the improvement by themselves (plowing, fertilizing, leveling, etc.) by requesting the PMU to compensate an amount equivalent to the amount of labor they spend. In fact, the PMU has compensated:

45. The actual amount received by the 03 AHs is 34% to 45% higher than that of the State. (See Annex 4: sample of payment receive for 01 AH out of 03 AHs)

46. By the end of the project / construction of 3 packages (October 2019). No written grievance has been received and no verbal complaints have been raised. GRM issues related to resettlement during the implementation of the project are in compliance with the following ADB approved DDR report:

47. In order to ensure that all questions and complaints from the local residents (not only relating to compensation and resettlement, but also other issues of the project) are addressed in a timely and satisfactory manner, and that all possible avenues are available to local residents to air their grievances, a well-defined grievance redress mechanism has been established to satisfy those requirement.

48. This mechanism will resolve concerns and complaints from affected households in an active and timely manner through an easy-to-understand and clear process that meets the requirements on gender equality and that is appropriate with local cultures and is easily accessed by all the affected residents with no cost. This mechanism will not cause any obstructions to access to the national judiciary and administrative systems. All expenses related to the grievance will be borne by the project.

49. The grievance redress procedure shall be implemented as follows:

#### **First Stage, Commune/Ward People's Committee**

An aggrieved APs may bring his/her complaint to the One Door Department of the Ward People's Committee, in writing or verbally. The member of WPC/CPC at the One Door Department will be responsible for notifying the WPC/CPC leaders about the complaint about solving. The Chairman of the WPC/CPC will meet personally with the aggrieved APs and will have 10 days following the receiving date of the complaint to resolve it. The WPC/CPC secretariat is responsible for documenting and keeping a file of all complaints handled by the WPC/CPC.

#### **Second Stage, District/Hue City People's Committee (DPC/HGPC)**

If after 30 days the aggrieved affected household does not hear from the WPC/CPC, or if the APs is not satisfied with the decision taken on his/her complaint, the APs may bring the case, either in

writing or verbally, to any member of the DPC/HPC of the district. The DPC/HPC, in turn, will have 30 days following the receiving date of the complaint to resolve the case. The DPC/HPC is responsible for documenting and keeping a file of all complaints that it handles and will inform the WPC/CPC of any decision made.

### **Third Stage, Provincial People's Committee (HuePPC)**

If after 30 days the aggrieved APs does not hear from the DPC/HPC, or if the APs is not satisfied with the decision taken on his/her complaint, the affected household may bring the case, either in writing or verbally, to any member of the HuePPC. The HuePPC has 45 days within which to resolve the complaint to the satisfaction of all concerned. The HuePPC secretariat is responsible for documenting and keeping files of all complaints handled by the HuePPC.

### **Final Stage, the Court of Law Arbitrates**

If after 45 days following the lodging of the complaint with the HuePPC, the aggrieved affected household does not hear from the HuePPC, or if he/she is not satisfied with the decision taken on his/her complaint, the case may be brought to a court of law for adjudication. The decision by the court will be the final decision.

50. A decision on solving the complaints must be sent to the aggrieved APs and concerned parties and must be posted at the office of the People's Committee where the complaint is solved. After 3 days, the decision/result on the solution is available at commune/ward level and after 7 days at district or city level. The Grievance redress procedure shall also be made available in the project's Public Information Booklet. The PMU is responsible for following-up the grievance process of the APs.

51. If efforts to resolve complaints or disputes are still unresolved and unsatisfactory following the project's grievance redress mechanism, the households have the right to send their concerns or problems directly to ADB's Southeast Asia Department (SERD) or through ADB Viet Nam Resident Mission. If the households are still not satisfied with the responses of SERD, they can directly contact the ADB's Office of the Special Project Facilitator as outlined in the Information Guide to the Consultation Phase of the ADB Accountability Mechanism.

52. Complaints processing by GoV shall be filed by the complaint resolution agency, with reference numbers on pages following the sequences of contents of the documents and maintained in accordance with legal regulations. In the event that an administrative complaint is brought to the Court, its documents shall be sent to the authorized Court for resolution as required. Forms to be used by the complaint resolution agencies for processing the complaints are provided in Circular No. 07/2013/TT-TTCT. The APs will not have to bear any administration costs. Furthermore, the complainant and those who submitted complaints to the court will have their legal representative without any costs.

53. In addition, should there be any requests for clarifications or complaints about construction implemented by the Contractor, one can contact representatives of the Contractor, the Engineer or the PMU directly via phone numbers provided on the project information boards at the worksite. Besides, for issues relating to water supply, the local people can contact HueWACO via the hot lines or send letters/e-mails to the address provided in water invoices or the company's website

54. The grievance redress mechanism has been disclosed to households at the offices of all subproject local locations (wards/communes/districts) where the project goes through and it will be continuously disseminated to people during project implementation. The project grievance procedure does not impede access to the court at any time.

## 2.5. Socio – economic information of AHs

55. The PMU conducted a survey and consultation of 91/378 affected households accounting for 24.1% of the affected households in 14 communes of 6 districts / towns / city all 3 CW03 packages. Of which, CW03 included 22 households accounting for 39.3%, CW05 included 33 households accounting for 18.6% and CW06 included 36 households accounting for 24.8%.

56. **Age of AH's head:** The majority of the age of the household head is between 46 and over, with 30.8% of the household head aged 46-55, followed by 28.6% from 56-65 and 24.2% aged over 65. The age of 35 and under accounts for a very small proportion of only 2.2%. Specific age is as follows:

57. **Education:** 52.7% heads of households with secondary education, 27.5% with primary school level, 15.4% with high school level. In the survey, there were also 4 members who cannot read or write.

58. **Household scale:** about 4.9 people / household. The household with the most members was 8 people and the least number of members was 2 people. The number of male members in the family (2.6 persons / household) was higher than that of female members (2.4 people / household). In the households, about 2.7 people are currently working with salaries. The average age of household head is about 57 years old.

59. **Main occupation:** 49.5% of surveyed households think that the main occupation of the household heads is agriculture and followed by 26.4% from hired labor. Households all claimed that their main source of income is from two main sources: agriculture (95.6%) and hired labor (83.5%). 67.3% said that both spouses are the main source of income in the family, followed by 24.2% of the source of income from children.

60. **Expenditure and income:** The expenditure of households was about 9.7 million VND / household and the income was about 11.6 million VND / household / month. Expenditure accounted for about 83.5% of total household income. Average income / person / month was



about 2.34 million. Survey results showed that Hue City and Huong Thuy Town were 2 areas with higher income levels than other districts / towns. Specifically, spending and income in the districts / towns / cities are as follows:

62. 100% households have televisions, 90.1% have motorbikes, 86.8% have phones, 72.5% have refrigerators, 18.7% have water heaters. In the survey, no households have a car

63. 91% surveyed households use tap water. All rated the tap water is good quality and they are used for drinking, washing and washing. Other households use water from dug wells and drilled wells, accounting for about 8.8%.

64. 85.7% affected households are currently using toilets / semi-septic toilets, 12.1% of households have 2 hygienic toilets, 1 household has no toilet. Household wastewater such as food, bathing and washing of households is mainly discharged / absorbed into their gardens. Most do not have a drainage system.

## 2.6. Assessment of affected households on the project

65. The surveyed households all said they knew about the water supply project. 100% of surveyed households received compensation.

66. Households was informed DMS and participated in this measurement. They all agreed DMS data and no grievances / complaints. Before receiving compensation money, each household was consulted his/her own compensation plan and provided their confirmation of compensation amount. In general, they were relatively satisfied with the project's compensation amount. As they were only partially affected by the project on trees and crops and according to local regulations, the compensation rate for this category is acceptable.

67. 49.5% affected households use compensation money for the purchase of household appliances, 56% buy seeds / plants, 22% pay for children's education / education, 2.2% pay land taxes.

68. 100% of households had no change in occupation as well as 98.9% think that their income did not change compared with before and after the project. Because the impact from the project on households was only a small and insignificant, 93.4% of households were satisfied with the current living standards and 5.5% of the households were relatively satisfied.

69. 85.8% of households think that their family did not face any difficulties at present. 12.4% of households think that they were facing difficulties with the lack of capital to do business or lack of human resources for employment.

70. The project has brought many benefits to the community. 83.5% said that they did not have to worry about lack of water, 71.4% said that clean water brought advantages and benefits for water use, and 70% of households gave opinions that clean water ensured their health.

71. However, some households in the survey also commented on the low level of compensation and support of the project but for general purposes, they were willing to support the project. At the same time, some households complained about the condition of the land after being returned made it impossible for them to cultivate due to the returned soil is clay

### **III. CONCLUSIONS AND RECOMMENDATION**

#### **3.1. Conclusion**

72. The project implementation started from April 10, 2018 and complete on November 2019. The information discloses and consultations with AHs, communities and local authorities in wards / communes / towns have been conducted through project implementation

73. Based on legal records / documents provided by the investor (as summarized), the site clearance and compensation for the 3 bidding packages of CW 03-05-06 have been carried out in accordance with project's policy and no complaints and grievances have been arisen until now.

74. Most people and local authorities were satisfied with the implementation of the project. The project has brought many benefits to the community. 83.5% said that they did not have to worry about lack of water, 71.4% said that clean water brought advantages and benefits for water use, and 70% of households gave opinions that clean water ensured their health. However, some households in the survey also commented on the low level of compensation and support of the project but for general purposes, they were willing to support the project.

75. The government and the community evaluated the project's construction progress was fast and did not much affect the community's life. The project did not affect the livelihoods of households because minor impacts to households.

76. The payment of compensation and support for affected households has been completed. In addition, 03 vulnerable households with affected assets on land are also provided with the support amount in compliance with the project resettlement framework (Annex 9). There were no complaints during the project implementation. There are no pending issues until the time of this report

77. Grievance mechanism was created in accordance with the resettlement framework. The complaints of the households have been resolved. Up to the reporting time, no affected households have any complaints.

### **3.2. Recommendation**

78. With the purpose of ensuring the entitlements of affected households under the Thua Thien Hue Water Supply Project, PMU with support of consultant is continuing the monitoring of the DDR implementation and they will be reflected in the next resettlement monitoring reports.






