ENTRY VISA

Those who need an entry visa should apply to the Philippines Embassy or Consulate in their country of origin. Visa on arrival is not advisable due to the time and cost involved.

AIR TRAVEL

Self-funded participants are expected to handle their travel arrangements.

We strongly suggest that you commence preparations for your travel to Manila as soon as possible. **Please note that your passport must be valid for at least six (6) months beyond the contemplated period of stay.**

AIRPORT TRANSFERS / LAND TRANSPORTATION

Accredited NAIA fixed rate or yellow metered taxis are available outside the arrival area of NAIA terminals. Taxi fares range from Php500 to Php1,000 (or about US\$15 to US\$23). Foreign exchange facilities are available in the airport. There are also accredited transfer services on a pre-paid coupon basis which currently charge a rate of Php670 to Php850 (or about US\$15 to US\$19) if drop-off or pick-up point is within the vicinity of ADB (Ortigas area). Accredited NAIA metered taxis—different from regular taxis—generally charge lower rates than pre-paid transfer services but may vary depending on travel time and traffic condition.

Airport transfers can also be arranged directly with hotels.
