1. The People's Republic of Bangladesh has received financing from the Asian Development Bank (ADB) toward the cost of **Emergency Assistance Project**. Part of this financing will be used for payments under the contract named above. Bidding is open to Bidders from eligible source countries of the ADB.

2. The **Local Government Engineering Department (LGED)** ("the Employer") invites online bids from eligible bidders for the construction and completion for the work mentioned below:

3. **Open Competitive Bidding (OCB) – National** will be conducted in accordance with ADB's Procurement Regulations through electronic Government Procurement (e-GP) system and is open to all Bidders from eligible countries as described in the Bidding Documents.

4. Only eligible Bidders with the following key qualifications should participate in this bidding:

- Specific Construction Experience:** The Bidder shall have the specific experience within the last five (5) years where the value equivalent of BDT90 million.
- Average Annual Construction Turnover:** The Bidder shall have average annual construction turnover of minimum BDT85 million.
- Liquid Assets or Credit Facilities:** The Bidder should have at least the amount of liquid asset or working capital of BDT25 million

More details of eligibility and qualification requirements are mentioned in the bidding documents.

5. This is an online bidding where only e-Tender (e-bid) will be accepted in the Bangladesh National e-GP System Portal and **no offline/hard copies will be accepted**. To obtain further

information and to submit e-Tender for this package, registration in the e-GP portal (<http://www.eprocure.gov.bd>) is required.

6. Eligible interested bidders can participate in the bidding procedure upon payment of BDT 4,000 (Taka four thousand only) in favor of the package toward the cost of bidding document as per the procedure described in the Bid Data Sheet. The tender security as mentioned in the documents have to be deposited online through any branch of the banks registered in the e-GP system.

7. **The deadline for submission of e-Tenders (bids) is 8 October 2018 at 15:00 hours ([Bangladesh Standard Time \(BST\)](#) and online opening will be done on the same date and time.**
