



## Invitation for Bids

The Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh has received financing from the Asian Development Bank (ADB) towards the cost of **Dhaka Water Supply Network Improvement Project (DWSNIP)**, and part of the proceeds of this financing will be used for payments under the contract named above. Bidding is open to all Bidders from eligible source countries of the ADB.

2. The **Dhaka Water Supply and Sewerage Authority** (Dhaka WASA, "the Purchaser") invites sealed bids from eligible Bidders for the **Supply, Installation & Commissioning of SCADA Software, GIS Software & other related works under DWSNIP** ("the Goods"). A brief description of the type of goods and related services including completion period are as below:

3. **International Competitive Bidding** will be conducted in accordance with ADB's [Single-Stage: Two-Envelope](#) Bidding Procedure through electronic Government Procurement (e-GP) system and is open to all Bidders from eligible source countries of ADB as described in the Bidding Documents.

4. Only eligible Bidders with the following key qualification should participate in this Bidding:

- Successful completion as main supplier within the last ten (10) years of at least five (5) contracts valued at US\$ 1.80 million with nature, and complexity similar to the scope of supply described in Section 6 (Schedule of Supply).

- The Bidder shall demonstrate that the goods offered have (i) been in production for at least five (5) years, and (ii) been sold similar type and specification over the last five (5) years; (iii) been in operation for a minimum of five (5) years.

The complete eligibility and qualification requirements are stipulated in the Bidding Documents.

The Bidding Document, in the English language, may be purchased directly or through authorized representative of interested Bidders upon submission of a written application to the address above and upon payment of a non-refundable fee BDT 5,000.00 or US\$ 60.00. The method of payment will be either in Demand Draft/Pay Order in favor of the “Project Director, Dhaka Water Supply Network Improvement Project (DWSNIP), Dhaka Water Supply and Sewerage Authority (Dhaka WASA), Dhaka, Bangladesh.” The Bidding Document may be collected in person or may be sent by express airmail for an additional fee of BDT 300.00 for domestic delivery or US\$ 80.00 for overseas delivery. No liability will be accepted for loss or late delivery.

7. Bids must be delivered to the address above **on or before 15 February 2022, 14:00 hours** accompanied by a Bid Security, as described in the Bidding Document. Bids will be opened immediately after the deadline for bid submission in the presence of Bidders’ representatives who choose to attend.

8. A Pre-Bid Meeting will be held at 11:30 hours (Bangladesh time) on 23 December 2021 at DWASA Conference Center, 3rd Floor, WASA Bhaban, Dhaka, Bangladesh.

9. The Purchaser will not be responsible for any cost or expense incurred by Bidders in connection with the preparation or delivery of bids.

10. When comparing Bids, ADB’s Domestic Preference Scheme will be applied in accordance with the provisions stipulated in the Bidding Document.
