1. The Kingdom of Cambodia has received financing from the Asian Development Bank (ADB) toward the cost of **Greater Mekong Subregion Tourism Infrastructure for Inclusive Growth Project (TIIG)**. Part of this financing will be used for payments under the contract named above. Bidding is open to Bidders from eligible source countries of ADB. This contract will be jointly financed by the Royal Government of Kingdom of Cambodia. The eligibility rules and procedures of ADB will govern the bidding process.

2. The **Ministry of Tourism on behalf of Royal Government of Cambodia** (“the Employer”) invites sealed bids from eligible Bidders for the construction and completion of the following contract package (“the Works”).

3. The Works include: construct a new passenger pier comprising (i) embankment stabilization and marine concrete work; (ii) arrival hall with customs and immigration facilities, administration offices, and commercial space; (iii) parking and supporting infrastructure including power and water supply, sanitation, and an on-site wastewater treatment system, and (iv) upgrade the existing access road.

4. **International Competitive Bidding** will be conducted in accordance with ADB’s [Single-Stage: One-Envelope](#) Bidding Procedure and is open to all Bidders from eligible countries.

5. Only eligible bidders with the following key qualifications should participate in this bidding:

- (i) The bidders’ net worth within last 3 years shall be positive.
- (ii) Minimum average annual construction turnover of US\$ 12,667,000 calculated as total certified payments received for contracts in progress or completed, within the last three (3) years.
- (iii) The Bidder must demonstrate that its financial resources defined in FIN - 3, less its financial obligations for its current contract commitments defined in FIN - 4, meet or exceed the total requirement for the Subject Contract of US\$ 2,111,000.

(iv) Participation in at least one contract that have been successfully or substantially completed within the last Five (5) years and that are similar to the proposed works, where the value of the Bidder's participation exceeds not less than US\$ 7,600,000. The similarity of the Bidder's participation shall be based on the physical size, nature of works, complexity, methods, technology or other characteristics as described in Section 6, Employer's Requirements.

7. To purchase the Bidding Documents in English, eligible bidders should

- (i) Write to address above (or through email) requesting the bidding document for TIIG-CAM-ICB-W01 Kampot Pier Development, Greater Mekong Subregion Tourism Infrastructure for Inclusive Growth Project (TIIG), ADB Loan No. 3194-CAM (SF).
- (ii) Payment of a nonrefundable fee of US\$200 excludes bank fees or its equivalent in Cambodian Riel. The method of payment will be in cash or deposit to Bank Account No. 000000013535 of National Bank of Cambodia. The Bidding Documents may be collected in person or may be sent by email or courier, but the bidder has to deposit the fee at the bank account and to pay for courier charge by his/her arrangement as appropriate at the discretion of bidder. Other than payment of the non-refundable fee specified above, there shall be no other conditions for the purchase of the bidding documents. Bidders should check with a sending bank on the total bank charge applicable including the receiving bank's fee.

The bidding documents can be purchased during normal working days from between 8:00 am – 12:00 am and 2:00 pm – 5:00 pm at the address under item 6 above, from 6 December 2017.

8. Deliver bids:

- (i) To the address given under item 6 above
- (ii) **On or before the deadline: 3:00PM (local time) on 17 January 2018.**
- (iii) Together with a Bid Security in the amount as specified in the Bidding Documents. For the purpose of determining the equivalent amount of the required Bid Security in a freely convertible currency, the selling exchange rate published by the National Bank of Cambodia on the date 28 days prior to the deadline for Bid submission shall be applied.

Bids will be opened immediately after the deadline, in the presence of bidders' representatives who choose to attend.

The bidder shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of its Bids and the Employer shall not be responsible or liable for those costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the bidding process.
