1. The Government of Georgia has received financing from the Asian Development Bank (ADB) toward the cost of **Sustainable Urban Transport Investment Program – Tranche 2**. Part of this financing will be used for payments under the Contract named above. Bidding is open to Bidders from eligible source countries of ADB.

2. The **Municipal Development Fund of Georgia** (“the Employer”) invites online bids through **Georgian E-Government Procurement System** from eligible Bidders for the construction and completion of Refurbishing of the Academic Center and Research Laboratory for Investigation and Testing of Bridges and Tunnels (ACRL) at the Georgian Technical University (GTU), including dismantling, full interior refurbishment, water works, electric works and cabling including purchase and delivery on site of all materials for all the works above (“the Works”). Construction period for the refurbishment works is 6 months.

3. **National Competitive Bidding** will be conducted through Georgian E-Government Procurement System in accordance with ADB’s [Single Stage: One Envelope](#) bidding procedure and is open to all Bidders from eligible countries as described in the Bidding Document.

4. Only eligible Bidders with but not limited to, the following key qualifications should participate in this bidding:

- (a) **Average Annual Construction Turnover:** Minimum average annual construction turnover of GEL 1,000,000.00 calculated as total certified payments received for contracts in progress or completed, within the last 3 (three) years (in case of Joint Venture: All Partners Combined must meet requirement; Each Partner must meet 25% of the requirement; One Partner must meet 50% of the requirement);
- (b) **Contracts of Similar Size and Nature:** Participation in at least one contract that has been successfully or substantially completed within the last 5 (five) years and that is similar to the proposed works, where the value of the Bidder’s participation exceeds GEL 290,000.00 (in case of Joint Venture One Partner must meet the requirement);
- (c) **Financial Resources Requirement:** The Bidder must demonstrate that it has the financial resources to meet: (a) its current contract commitments, plus (b) the requirements for the Subject Contract of GEL 185,000 or equivalent (in case of Joint

Venture: All Partners Combined must meet requirement; Each Partner must meet 25 % of the requirement; One Partner must meet 50% of the requirement). Details are provided in the Section 3 of bidding documents.

6. Bidding Documents in English language are available for download from Georgian E-Government Procurement System from 25 January 2018 to 26 February 2018 free of charge
7. Bids must be submitted through Georgian E-Government Procurement System on or before 26 February 2018, 12:00 Noon (Tbilisi time). Bidders shall indicate bid price in electronic field in Georgian E-Government Procurement System, failing to do so, will result in rejection of such bid. Bids shall be opened electronically using Georgian E-Government Procurement System on 26 February 2018, 12:00 Noon (Tbilisi time).
8. A pre-bid meeting with bidders shall be held at 12:00 Noon (Tbilisi time) on 12 February 2018. Interested bidders to visit the project site can do so until 21 February 2018 under intimation to the Employer. The bidders interested in participating in the bid process are advised to attend the pre-bid meeting and the site visit before submission of bids.
