

## Invitation for Bids

1. Georgia has received a loan from the Asian Development Bank (ADB) towards the cost of the **Urban Services Investment Program - Tranche 3**. Part of this loan will be used for payments under the contract named above. Bidding is open to Bidders from eligible source countries of the ADB.
2. The **United Water Supply Company of Georgia (UWSCG)** invites sealed bids from eligible Bidders for the **improvement of water supply system in Telavi**, in particular, construction of six (6) new water supply boreholes and rehabilitation of five (5) existing boreholes, laying of 1.4 km long transmission pipe and 59 km network pipes, installation of house connections, works for individual metering of apartments, construction of five (5) new reservoirs with 7,000 m<sup>3</sup> total volume. The estimated construction period for whole of the works is 540 days.
3. **International Competitive Bidding (ICB)** will be conducted in accordance with ADB's [Single Stage – One Envelope](#) procedure and is open to all bidders from eligible countries as described in the Bidding Document.
4. The minimum key qualification criteria include, **but are not limited** to the following:
  - Average Annual Construction Turnover: Minimum average annual turnover of US\$ 13 million or equivalent calculated as total certified payments received for contracts in progress or completed, within the last three (3) years (in case of Joint Venture: Each partner must meet 25% and One partner - 40% of the requirement);
  - Financial Resources: The Bidder must demonstrate access to, or availability of liquid assets, lines of credit, or other financial resources, to meet the Bidder's financial resources requirements in the amount of US\$ 2 million or equivalent (in case of Joint Venture: Each partner must meet 25 % and One partner - 40% of the requirement); and
  - Contract of Similar Size and Nature: Participation in at least one contract that has been successfully or substantially completed within the last five (5) years and that is similar to the proposed works, where the value of the Bidder's participation exceeds US\$ 7,8 million or equivalent. The similarity of the Bidder's participation shall be based on the physical size, nature of works, complexity, methods, technology or other characteristics as described in Section 6, Employer's

Requirements of the bidding documents (in case of Joint Venture: One partner must meet the requirement).
