



## Invitation for Bids

1. The Government of the Republic of Indonesia has received financing from the Asian Development Bank (ADB) toward the cost of **Metropolitan Sanitation Management Investment Project**. Part of this financing will be used for payments under the contract named above. Bidding is open to Bidders from eligible source countries of ADB.
2. The **Procurement Working Group (Pokja), Working Unit for the Implementation of Regional II South Sulawesi Province, Regional Office for Implementing the Selection of Construction Services (BP2JK) of South Sulawesi, Directorate General of Construction Development, Ministry of Public Works and Housing** invites sealed bids from eligible Bidders for the **Construction of Wastewater Treatment Plant in Makassar (Makassar WWTP B1)** (“the Works”).
3. **International Competitive Bidding (ICB)** will be conducted in accordance with the ADB’s [Single Stage – Two Envelope](#) bidding procedure and is open to all eligible Bidders as described in the Bidding Document.
4. Only eligible Bidders with the following key qualifications should participate in this bidding:
  - Minimum average annual turnover of USD 10,482,111 calculated as total certified payments received for contracts in progress or completed, within the last three (3) years.
  - Participation in at least: (i) one DB contract in Design and Construction of WWTP where the value of the Bidder’s participation exceeds USD 7,861,583 that has been successfully completed as evidenced by Provisional Hand Over/Taking-Over Certificate within 2010-2019, or (ii) one contract in designing WWTP as evidenced by contract, and one contract in constructing WWTP where the value of Bidder’s participation exceeds USD 7,625,736, that has been successfully completed as evidenced by Provisional Hand Over/Taking-Over Certificate within 2010-2019. The similarity of the Bidder’s participation shall be based on the physical size, nature of works, complexity, methods, technology or other characteristics of the Works.
  - For the above or other contracts executed during the period stipulated above, a minimum design or construction experience of compartmentalized MBBR or other similar technologies WWTP at least with the capacity of 8,000 m<sup>3</sup>/day. Supply and installation of electrical and mechanical equipment compatible with the technology presented above.

The qualification criteria are more completely described in the Bidding Document.
