



## Invitation for Bids

1. The **Government of Mongolia** has received financing from the Asian Development Bank (ADB) toward the cost of the **Regional Improvement of Border Services Project** and it intends to apply part of the proceeds of this financing to payment under the Contract named above. Bidding is open to Bidders from eligible source countries of ADB.

2. The **Ministry of Finance** (“the Purchaser”) invites sealed Bids from eligible Bidders for supply of goods under package “**G4.2: Second Phase CAIS Equipment Upgrade**” including the following:

- Servers and network Equipment
- Back-up Appliances
- Information Exchange Platform
- Business Intelligence Tool
- Oracle Database Enterprise Edition
- Tablet mobile devices; and
- Unlimited Power Supply (UPS)

Detailed specifications of goods are provided in the Section 6 of the Bidding Document. Expected delivery period will be **3 months** from the date of signing the contract.

3. **International competitive bidding** will be conducted in accordance with ADB’s Single-Stage: One-Envelope (1S1E) procedure and is open to all Bidders from eligible source countries of ADB as described in the Bidding Document.

4. Only eligible Bidders with the following key qualifications should participate in this bidding:

- Having at least **3 years’ experience** of supplying the goods similar to goods being procured;
- Successful completion as main supplier within the last three (3) years (2017, 2018, 2019), of at least two (2) contracts, each valued at **US\$1,000,000 (One Million US dollars)**, with nature, and complexity similar to the scope of supply described in Section 6 (Schedule of Supply);
- Minimum average annual turnover of **US\$1,500,000 (One Million Five Hundred**

**Thousand US dollars)** calculated as total payments received by the Bidder for contracts completed or under execution over the last three (3) years (2017, 2018, 2019);

- Be an authorized dealer or distributor of the goods being procured.

Bidder that does not conduct business with Mongolia shall submit evidence that it will be represented by an agent in the country equipped and able to carry out the Supplier's maintenance, repair and spare parts-stocking obligations prescribed in the Conditions of Contracts and/or Technical Specifications.
