1. The Government of Nepal has received loan from Asian Development Bank (ADB) toward the cost of **Urban Water Supply and Sanitation (Sector) Project (UWSSP)**. Part of this financing will be used payments under the contracts named above. Bidding is open to Bidders from eligible source countries of ADB.

2. The **Project Management Office, Urban Water Supply and Sanitation (Sector) Project (UWSSP), Department of Water Supply and Sewerage management, Ministry of Water Supply** (“the Employer”) invites electronic bids from eligible Bidders for the scope of works described hereunder:

Stage- 1: Deep Tube Wells, Treatment Plants, Generator House, Over Head Tank, Valve Chambers, Pump House, Pipe and fittings procurement and laying, Fire Hydrant, Household connections, Electro-mechanical installation including SCADA. The construction period is two (2) years from the date of issuing of the work order.

Stage- 2: Operations and Maintenance of the Water Supply and Sanitation Component is one (1) year.

3. **Open Competitive Bidding (International Advertisement)** will be conducted in accordance with ADB’s [Single Stage: Two-Envelope](#) envelope bidding procedure and is open to all Bidders from eligible countries as described in the Bidding Document.

4. Only eligible Bidders with the following key qualifications should participate in this bidding:

- Minimum average annual construction turnover of NRs. 532 million or equivalent calculated as total certified payments received for contracts in progress or completed within the last five (5) years.
- Participation in at least one (1) contract that has been successfully or substantially completed within the last seven (7) years that is similar to the proposed works, where the value of the Bidder’s participation exceeds NRs. 425 million or equivalent. The similarity of the Bidder’s participation shall be based on Water supply and Sanitation or Wastewater Project.

More details of qualification requirements are mentioned in the Bidding Documents.

- Together with a Bid Security in the amount as specified in the Bidding Document and upload an electronic copy of the bank deposit/voucher/cash receipt/wire transfer when submitting the bid.

Note: Paper submission of bid is not permitted. Only electronically submitted bids will be considered for evaluation.

Technical bids will be opened in the presence of Bidder's representatives who choose to attend on 8 November 2021; 12:30 hours (NST) at the Project Management Office, Urban Water Supply and Sanitation (Sector) Project, Panipokhari, Kathmandu, whereas the Financial Bids shall remain unopened. The Price Bids of only Technically Responsive and Qualified Bidders shall be

opened after Technical Bid Evaluation, whereas the Price Bids of those Bidders whose Technical Bids are not responsive and qualified shall be unopened.

8. When comparing bids, ADB's Domestic Preference Scheme will be applied in accordance with the provisions stipulated in the Bidding Document.
