1. The Islamic Republic of Pakistan has received financing from the Asian Development Bank (ADB) towards the cost of **Sindh Provincial Road Improvement Project**. Part of this financing will be used for payments under the contracts named hereunder. Bidding is open to Bidders from eligible source countries of ADB.

2. The **Works & Services Department** (WSD, the Employer) invites sealed bids from eligible Bidders for the **Rehabilitation and Improvement of Sindh Provincial Road** (the Works):

3. Contract duration for each of the three (3) lots is 365 days.

4. Bidders may bid for one or several lots, as further defined in the Bidding Document(s). As the Employer is simultaneously inviting bids for the above three (3) lots, the Employer will evaluate and compare bids submitted for each lot separately. If a Bidder submits successful (substantially responsive lowest evaluated) bids for more than one lot, the evaluation will also include an assessment of the Bidder's capacity to meet the aggregate requirements for two (2) or more contracts in terms of Average Annual Construction Turnover, Financial Resources Requirement, Equipment to be allocated and Personnel to be fielded in accordance with 1.6 "Multiple Contracts" in Section-3".

5. **International competitive bidding** will be conducted in accordance with ADB's Single-Stage: Two-Envelope bidding procedure and is open to all Bidders from eligible countries as described in the Bidding Document(s).

6. National Bidders are required to be registered with Pakistan Engineering Council with a valid registration Certificate as per requirements stated in the Bidding Document(s) (for each lot).

7. To purchase the Bidding Document(s) in English, eligible Bidders should:

- Write to address below requesting for the Bidding Document(s) for (insert number and title of contract) as mentioned in the table above.
- Pay a non-refundable fee of **PKR 10,000/-** (Pak Rupees Ten Thousand Only) or **US\$ 80** (US Dollars Eighty only) by Pay Order / Demand Draft in favor of **Project Director**,

Project Management Unit, Sindh Provincial Road Improvement Project, Works & Services Department Sindh Hyderabad Pakistan.

- The eligible Bidders also have the option to download the Bidding Document(s) **free of cost** from Sindh Provincial Road Improvement Project website i.e. (<http://www.spripwsd.gos.pk/>).
 - Eligible Bidders opting to download the Bidding Document(s) from SPRIP website shall inform PMU-SPRIP; WSD Sindh in writing at the address given below for clarification, failing which PMU-SPRIP, WSD Sindh shall not be responsible if the Bidder does not receive clarifications and amendments, if any. In case of any discrepancy between the downloaded document and hard copy, the latter shall prevail.
8. To obtain further information and inspect the Bidding Document(s), Bidders should contact the Project Director at the address mentioned below.
9. A pre-bid meeting for all the three (3) lots shall take place on **22 November 2018 at 11:00 hours** at the address mentioned below.
10. Deliver your bid(s):
- to the address below
 - **on or before 17 December 2018 at 11:00 hours (local time).**
 - together with a Bid Security as specified / required in the Bidding Document(s).
 - Electronic submission of Bids is not allowed.
11. Technical Bids will be opened on **17 December 2018 at 11:30 hours** in the presence of Bidders' representatives who choose to attend, whereas the Financial Bids shall remain sealed and unopened and shall be placed locked. The Financial Bids of only Technically Responsive and Qualified Bidders shall be opened after technical bids evaluation, whereas, the financial bids of those Bidders whose technical bids are not responsive and qualified shall be returned unopened.
