1. The Islamic Republic of Pakistan has received for financing from **Asian Development Bank (ADB)** toward the cost of **Second Power Transmission Enhancement Investment Program – Tranche 3**. Part of this financing will be used for payments under the contract named above. No nationality restrictions apply, other than any restrictions arising from ITB 4.8.
2. The **National Transmission and Despatch Company** (NTDC, “the Employer”) invites sealed bids from eligible Bidders for the **Procurement and supply of transmission line construction equipment and live line crew equipment**, as detailed and specified in the Bidding Documents. The Time for Completion as described in the bidding documents, shall be **270 days** from the Effective Date of each Lot as described in the Bidding Documents.
3. **International Competitive Bidding** will be conducted in accordance with the ADB’s [Single-Stage: One-Envelope](#) bidding procedure and is open to all Bidders without nationality restrictions.
4. Only eligible Bidders with the following main key qualifications should participate in this bidding:
 - The bidder must satisfy the evaluation and qualification criteria as described in Section 3 of the Bidding Documents against each Lot including the following key requirements:

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Successful completion as main supplier within the last 10 (ten) years, of at least 2 (two) contracts each valued at:

Lot I: USD 1,779,645
Lot II: USD 231,120
Lot III: USD 844,376
Lot IV: USD 1,600,000
Lot V: USD 1,120,000

similar to the scope of supply described in Section 4 (Price Schedules) and Section-VI "Employer's Requirements" **And**

- The Bidder/proposed manufacturer(s)/sub-contractor(s) shall demonstrate that the goods offered have been in production for at least 5 (five) years".
